Tom had to admit, he was becoming a cynical person. He seemed to be filled with fear all the time and was often distracted and becoming distant with

his family and friends.

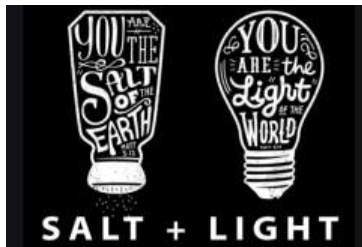
This negative attitude started to take root in him when things at work seemed to become more complicated and harder to manage. When he first started his job things would go smoothly, and if there were problems, they were quickly and fairly resolved. But with the change in leadership at the very top of the organization, things started to change. Now “process” became everything and the people involved in those processes seemed not to matter. Nor did the amount of work thrown on staff matter. Nothing was ever taken away, things were just added.

It also looked to Tom that decisions were being made all for the wrong reasons. In general, he thought the leaders of the organization were losing the transparency that had originally attracted him to want to work for this company. And Tom had to admit, he wasn't getting the affirmation he had been getting under the previous leadership. So this made him second guess himself all the time and he started losing confidence in himself.

People began to see a change in Tom. All of this was having an effect on his personality. His wife and children of course noticed it first, but his closest friends saw something was wrong as well. Tom wasn't himself and the vibe he was sending to those around him was not all that positive. Tom

was seeing these changes in himself and couldn't deny any of this. He needed to really take a long hard look at the general direction of his life. He realized he needed to regroup and reclaim the person he was supposed to be—the person God wanted him to be.

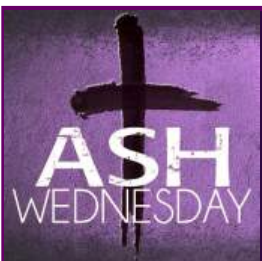
Jesus says to his disciples: “You are the salt of the earth...You are the light of the world.” He's not talking about himself, he's telling his followers—and that includes us—what we should be for others. Sometimes things can happen in our own lives (like the person in the story I shared with you) that begin to interfere with the effect that we can have on others, especially those closest to us. If we lose who we are we can't be salt and light for others.



And what does it mean to be salt, to be light? In saying that his disciples are “salt of the earth”, Christ is describing the critical character of the Christian vocation. *Either* the Christian heightens the quality of human life and makes it more palatable, more delightfully nourishing, or he has no

reason for being. “Salt is not for itself, cannot be its own end; it serves a humble yet somehow indispensable purpose. Insipid Christians (lacking in qualities that interest, stimulate, or challenge), those who have lost their proper flavor, have forgotten their function as a condiment of society... No doubt they let this happen by blending into the common environment, out of exhaustion, perhaps, or for some other reason...fear maybe...

Same for the light. Christ is telling us, ‘and by your presence others shall see better’. Salt and light each impart their own virtue, provided they remain fully what they are.

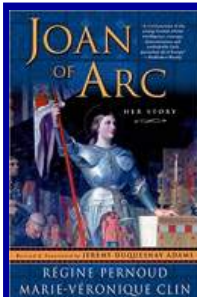

St. Joan of Arc, the Maid of Orléans, was born ~1412; she was a peasant girl who, believing that she was acting under divine guidance, led the French army in a momentous victory that repulsed an English attempt to conquer France during the Hundred Years' War. Joan was burned to death at 19 years old by the English and their French collaborators as a heretic.

In 1456, an inquisitorial court reinvestigated Joan's trial and overturned the verdict, declaring that it was tainted by deceit and procedural errors.

THIS YEAR THE NAMESAKE SAINTS FOR OUR SPIRITUAL BABY ARE TAKEN FROM THE SAINTS RECALLED IN EUCHARISTIC PRAYER I—THE ROMAN CANON. THIS IS THE OLDEST EUCHARISTIC PRAYER USED IN THE MASS AND DATES TO AT LEAST THE 7TH CENTURY; ITS CORE, HOWEVER, IS MUCH, MUCH OLDER. THE SAINTS RECALLED PROVIDE INSPIRATION FOR US!



OUR SPIRITUAL CHILDREN:
LUKE—2018,
JEROME—2019,
CECILIA—2020,
JOSEPH—2021 AND
MAXIMILLIAN—2022

The Roman Canon contains two prayers that list specific saints. The first, the *Communicantes*, is prayed before the Consecration. The second, the *Nobis quoque peccatoribus*, is prayed after. When the Church invokes these saints, she receives the prayers of powerful intercessors in Heaven. They remind us that we are members of the Body of Christ. *Saints of the Roman Canon, pray for us!*

The *Communicantes*: “In communion with those whose memory we venerate, especially the glorious ever-Virgin Mary, Mother of God and Lord, Jesus Christ, and blessed Joseph, her Spouse, your blessed Apostles and Martyrs...” (the invocation of Joseph was added by Pope John XXIII).

Then 24 saints follow: The number is significant for two reasons. First it is 2 x 12. The number twelve denotes the fullness of God's people.

- **The first are the 12 Apostles:** “Peter and Paul, Andrew, James, John, Thomas, James, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Simon and Jude.” – Judas Iscariot is not included for obvious reasons. However, Matthias, the Apostle who replaced Judas is also absent but appears in the *Nobis quoque*; instead, Saint Paul is included at the head of the list to bring the number of Apostles to 12.
- **The next 12 are early martyrs of the Catholic Church:** “Linus, Cletus, Clement, Sixtus, Cornelius, Cyprian, Lawrence, Chrysogonus, John and Paul, Cosmas and Damian.” These saints represent the hierarchy of the Catholic Church: Pope, bishop, deacon, laity.

The first five are martyred Popes:

1. **Saint Linus** – the second Pope; successor to Saint Peter
2. **Saint Cletus** – the third Pope; martyred after building a temple on St. Peter's tomb, destined as a resting place for martyrs
3. **Saint Clement** – the fourth Pope; Peter and Paul's disciple
4. **Saint Sixtus II** – reigned as Pope from A.D. 257-258 and martyred under the persecutions of the Emperor Valerian. His beloved deacon was the well-known Saint Lawrence.
5. **Saint Cornelius** – reigned as Pope from A.D. 251-253. During his pontificate he was opposed by the priest Novation who had declared himself Pope (the priest was later excommunicated). He was martyred under the Emperor Gallus.

The next is a martyred bishop:

6. **Saint Cyprian** – born a pagan but converted to Christianity, he was a defender of the Catholic faith; Some of his writings are used in the Divine Office; he was beheaded in Carthage, Africa in AD 258.

A martyred deacon:

7. **Saint Lawrence** – martyred under the same Valerian edict that condemned Pope Saint Sixtus II; He was roasted alive on a grid iron.

And finally, martyred laymen:

8. **Saint Chrysogonus** was an official that was martyred in the persecutions of Emperor Diocletian; He was a non-Roman but was widely venerated in Rome as monuments to his honor attest.
- 9 & 10. **Saints John and Paul**, brothers, were martyred under Julian the Apostate.
- 11 & 12. **Saints Cosmas and Damian**, brothers, were physicians who offered their skills without charge; they were martyred in Syria, around A.D. 287 during the Diocletian persecutions.



THESE SAINTS NOT ONLY REPRESENT POPES, BISHOPS, DEACONS, AND LAITY OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH—THEY REPRESENT THE EARLY CHURCH ACROSS ROME, EUROPE (CHRYSOGONUS), AFRICA (CYPRIAN), AND ASIA (COSMAS & DAMIAN)!

THEIR MARTYRDOMS PLACE THE PRAYER IN THE LATE AD 300S OR 400S WHICH ALIGNS WITH THE ROMAN TRADITION THAT THE CANON OF THE MASS WAS ESTABLISHED IN ESSENCE BY POPE SAINT DAMASUS (AD 366-84). POPE INNOCENT (AD 401-17) REVEALED THAT THE CANON OF THE MASS WAS ESTABLISHED AND RECEIVED AS SOMETHING SACRED.

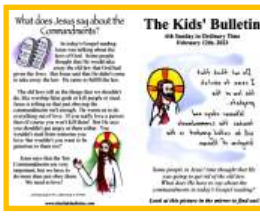
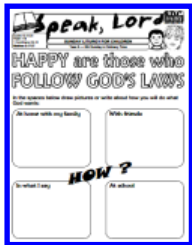
The saints in the second prayer, the *Nobis quoque peccatoribus*, are highlighted on the back page.

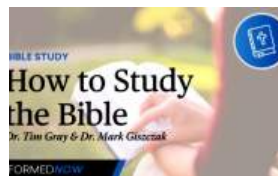

Saints of Eucharistic Prayer I—Continued:

The second list of saints in the Roman Canon is in the *Nobis quoque peccatoribus*: it opens with Saint John the Baptist, who announced the coming of Jesus. Then 7 male saints and 7 female saints are recalled—7 is the number of completion, thus these two groups of 7 saints symbolize the complete number of all male and female saints; and so all the saints are implicitly included:

- **John the Baptist**, the greatest prophet
- 1. **Stephen**, the first Martyr of the Christian era
- 2. **Matthias**, selected to replace Judas Iscariot
- 3. **Barnabas**, persuaded the apostles to accept Paul as a disciple
- 4. **Ignatius of Antioch**, convert to Christianity, a disciple of John the Apostle; a martyr bishop
- 5. **Alexander**, martyred along with two others
- 6 & 7. **Marcellinus and Peter** were a priest and exorcist who were martyred together.
- 1 & 2. **Felicity and Perpetua**, martyrs from Africa; sentenced death via the public games in Rome but the wild beasts would not approach them so they were killed by the sword.
- 3. **Agatha**, tortured and martyred for refusing the advances of a consul in Sicily
- 4. **Lucy**, denounced as a Christian by the man she refused to marry and martyred
- 5. **Agnes**, denounced for her commitment to remain a virgin; martyred in Rome
- 6. **Cecilia**, martyred for burying the bodies of Christian martyrs in Rome
- 7. **Anastasia**, a virgin martyr for the Faith; Croatia.
