At the beginning of the Easter Vigil there are words spoken as the Paschal Candle is being prepared. These words can easily get lost in the activity that takes place outside church around the Easter fire. So here are the words again; they are spoken as the priest is tracing the cross and the four numerals of the current year:

Christ yesterday and today  
the Beginning and the End  
the Alpha  
and the Omega  
*All time belongs to him*  
and all the ages  
To him be glory and power  
through every age and for ever.

Amen.  
*All time belongs to him.* All time belongs to Christ!  
Time: For one person, a precious gift; for someone else, a terrible burden; We know too well what can happen in the space of a year or a moment. Sickness can overtake the world. Falling in love may comically rearrange our priorities. Disappointment or loss drops us down a well of despair. An act of sudden kindness restores our hope.

*All time belongs to him.*  
If time belongs to Christ, then we must learn to trust in him. And think of what it is that the Risen Christ has accomplished for us!  
Death is turned into new life.



What does that mean for us? Well, think of it this way: Time lost has been regained. The time we have spent grieving our sins, fueling our anger, harboring our resentments, mourning our losses, reliving our regrets can be changed to time lived in patience, thankfulness, perseverance, charity, joy and hope.

For many of us these past twelve months have really tested our faith and made us question a lot of things. And maybe in the stress of daily life we have been looking at the whole course of our life and the way we have spent "our time". This Easter, as we begin to see the light at the end of the tunnel, we are asked to see the true light and remember that "all time belongs to him—to Christ".

Because Christ has risen from the dead we can live in trust and hope and learn to "spend our time" differently than we have been spending it. We're grateful that Christ is the healer of yesterday, with its broken dreams and confused loyalties; the healer of words uttered in haste that can't be unspoken.

Our Easter joy helps us to acknowledge that Christ is present at the start and end of every journey. Through Christ we can regain the true path.

All time belongs to him, and all the ages...

And because of this *time becomes an ocean of possibility, so we must seek its consecration, making the future a holy destination to which we can all travel together.*

## What does the word "Alleluia" mean?

What exactly are we saying when we exclaim, "He is risen! Alleluia"?

*Alleluia* is the well-known proclamation of Easter joy. All through Lent we haven't seen or spoken a single syllable of the word, but now it bursts forth everywhere we look.

The word comes to us from the Jews—it was their cry of praise to God. It is often used in the Psalms.

In Hebrew, *Allelu* is an exclamation reserved for divine praise meaning "All hail" or "Glory in the highest." *la* refers to God Himself, "Him Who Is."

*Allelu-ia*, therefore, means "All hail to Him Who Is" or even—roughly—"Glory to God in the highest."

When Catholics adopted the phrase, it soon became very important in the Liturgy and Office.

It is always removed during Lent because of its joyful character, and returns with the great celebrations of Easter:

During Eastertime it is the characteristic Paschal note of varying parts of Mass and Office, constantly appearing at the beginning and end, and even in the middle, of psalms, as an instinctive exclamation of ecstatic joy. --The Catholic Encyclopedia

### Did you know...

- ◆ SJN church has limited space in the sanctuary (area around the altar) for the celebrants and assistants to best manage the liturgy.
- ◆ As a place of worship to God and in celebration of God's glory and gift of salvation, aesthetics and furnishings should express that glory and raise our spirits to God and enrich our faith.
- ◆ Our liturgical designer brings us a wealth of knowledge and understanding of liturgy and the purpose of ecclesiastical architecture that will be invaluable for our project.
- ◆ SCJN School has been authorized by the Township to use trailers as two modular classrooms for a short time; a long-term solution is needed.
- ◆ The PreK3 & PreK4 programs have been a successful means of introducing families to our school & parish and enabling longer-term student enrollment. Our PreK3 class size is not as large as it could be due to limited space..
- ◆ Enrollment and student retention in the upper grades has increased in recent years, causing the downsizing, sharing of space, or elimination of some classrooms (such as science and technology) to make room for homeroom classrooms. Due to lack of space, some teachers 'travel' to the students' homeroom classroom for instruction (sometimes with limited teaching tools on a cart).

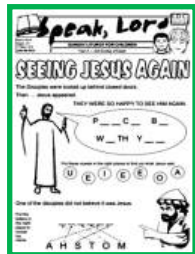

*Apr. 21: St. Anselm (1033-1109)*

Indifferent toward religion as a young man, Anselm became one of the Church's greatest theologians and leaders. He received the title "Father of Scholasticism" for his attempt to analyze and illumine the truths of faith through the aid of reason.



At 15, Anselm wanted to enter a monastery, but was refused acceptance because of his father's opposition. Twelve years later, after careless disinterest in religion and years of worldly living, he finally fulfilled his desire to be a monk. He entered the monastery of Bec in Normandy, was elected prior three years later, and 15 years later, was unanimously chosen abbot.

Considered an original and independent thinker, Anselm was admired for his patience, gentleness, and teaching skill. Under his leadership, the Abbey of Bec became a monastic school, influential in philosophical and theological studies.

During these years, at the community's request, Anselm began publishing his theological works, comparable to those of Saint Augustine. His best-known work is the book *Cur Deus Homo* ("Why God Became Man").

Against his will, Anselm was appointed archbishop of Canterbury in 1093, at age 60. His appointment was opposed at first by England's King William Rufus and later accepted. Rufus persistently refused to cooperate with efforts to reform the Church.

Anselm finally went into voluntary exile until Rufus died in 1100. He was then recalled to England by Rufus' brother and successor, Henry I. Disagreeing fearlessly with Henry over the king's insistence on investing England's bishops, Anselm spent another three years in exile in Rome.

His care and concern extended to the very poorest people. Opposing the slave trade, Anselm obtained from the national council at Westminster the passage of a resolution prohibiting the sale of human beings.

Like every true follower of Christ, Anselm had to carry his cross, especially in the form of opposition and conflict with those in political control. Though personally a mild and gentle man and a lover of peace, he would not back off from conflict and persecution when principles were at stake.
