Maria was a poor widow who lived in a Brazilian village with her 15 year old daughter, Christina. For years they had survived on Maria's humble salary. Now

her beautiful, joyful daughter Christina wanted to find a job too. She dreamed about an exciting life in the big city, even though her mother tried to convince her that a poor, uneducated young girl would only find trouble there.

One morning Maria awoke to find her daughter's bed empty. Maria knew immediately where her daughter had gone and set out to find her. On her way to the bus stop she went to a photograph booth at the drugstore and spent all she could on pictures of herself. With her purse full of small black and white photos, she boarded the next bus to Rio de Janeiro.

Maria knew Christina had no way of earning money but was too stubborn to give up. When pride meets hunger, a human will do things that were before unthinkable. Maria began her search through bars, hotels, nightclubs, and other places with a reputation for street walkers. At each place she left her picture-taped to a hotel bulletin board, fastened to a corner phone booth. And on the back of each photo, she wrote a note.

Soon Maria's money and photos ran out, and she took the bus back to her small village.

A month later young Christina descended the stairway at a cheap hotel. Her face was tired; her formerly joyful eyes now spoke of pain and fear. Her dream had become a nightmare. She felt hopeless, trapped, and ashamed, and wanted to go home. Yet the little village was, in many ways, too far away.

As she reached the bottom of the stairs, her eyes noticed a familiar face. She looked again, and taped on the lobby mirror was a small picture of her mother. Christina's eyes burned and her throat tightened as she walked across the room and removed the small photo. Written on the back was this compelling invitation: "Whatever you have done, whatever you have become, it doesn't matter. Please come home."

She did.

Jesus is God's picture "taped" to a Roman cross, inviting us to come home, so he can save us from the destructive power of sin.

This past Sunday was Divine Mercy Sunday, and the message of God's love, mercy and forgiveness is a powerful one! It's a message that we should be mindful of throughout the year. In closing, I offer you the ABC's of Divine Mercy: a. Ask for mercy; b. Be merciful; c. Completely trust in Jesus.

### *Apr. 24: St. Fidelis of Sigmaringen (1577-1622)*

If a poor man needed some clothing, Fidelis would often give the man the clothes right off his back. Complete generosity to others characterized this saint's life.

Born in 1577, Mark Rey became a lawyer who constantly upheld the causes of the poor and oppressed people. Nicknamed "the poor man's lawyer," Rey soon grew disgusted with the corruption and injustice he saw among his colleagues. He left his law career to become a priest, joining his brother George as a member of the Capuchin Order. Fidelis was his religious name. His wealth was divided between needy seminarians and the poor. As a follower of Saint Francis of Assisi, Fidelis continued his devotion to the weak and needy. During a severe epidemic in a city where he was guardian of a friary, Fidelis cared for and cured many sick soldiers.

He was appointed head of a group of Capuchins sent to preach against the Calvinists and Zwinglians in Switzerland. Almost certain violence threatened. Those who observed the mission felt that success was more attributable to the prayer of Fidelis during the night than to his sermons and instructions. He was accused of opposing the peasants' national aspirations for independence from Austria. While he was preaching at Seewis, to which he had gone, against the advice of his friends, a gun was fired at him, but he escaped unharmed. A Protestant offered to shelter Fidelis, but he declined, saying his life was in God's hands. On the road back, he was set upon by a group of armed men and killed.

Fidelis was canonized in 1746. Fifteen years later he was recognized as a martyr.

Fidelis' constant prayer was that he be kept completely faithful to God and not give in to any lukewarmness or apathy. He was often heard to exclaim, "Woe to me if I should prove myself but a halfhearted soldier in the service of my thorn-crowned Captain." His prayer against apathy, and his concern for the poor and weak make him a saint whose example is valuable today. The modern Church is calling us to follow the example of "the poor man's lawyer" by sharing ourselves and our talents with those less fortunate and by working for justice in the world.

## SURVEY FINDINGS



### SURVEY BACKGROUND:

The survey questions may have been a bit unexpected; they were designed in the context of what sacred architecture is meant to achieve and the purpose of a parish school. It was simply the beginning of our parish conversation about a possible church renovation and school expansion.

In some ways, the purpose of the survey was to challenge us to look at our church from different points of view.

The designers and architects have the results, which offers them an additional perspective. The Steering Committee has shared insights about our worship & school experience, situation, and needs as well.

### NEXT STEPS:

- ◆ **THE DESIGNERS AND ARCHITECTS ARE DEVELOPING CONCEPTS FOR BOTH THE CHURCH AND SCHOOL FOR OUR PARISH TO CONSIDER.**
- ◆ **THE NEXT SURVEY, THE FEASIBILITY/PLANNING STUDY, WILL SHARE THESE CONCEPTS WITH YOU. WE NEED YOUR PERSPECTIVE AND OPINIONS. WE ARE, AGAIN, GRATEFUL FOR YOUR PARTICIPATION IN THIS IMPORTANT STEP AS WE EXPLORE RENOVATION OPTIONS TO PREPARE FOR OUR FUTURE:**
  - \* **STARTING MAY 1, WE WILL CONDUCT THIS PARISH-WISE PLANNING STUDY. WE HAVE HIRED THE STEIER GROUP, A CATHOLIC DEVELOPMENT FIRM TO CONDUCT THE REVIEW, WHICH WILL BENEFIT US GREATLY TO FINALIZE OUR PROJECT FOCUS.**
  - \* **THE STUDY WILL ALSO HELP IDENTIFY CAMPAIGN LEADERS AND VOLUNTEERS, SHOULD WE DECIDE TO MOVE FORWARD WITH A CAPITAL CAMPAIGN.**

### WE HAD A VERY LARGE RESPONSE TO THE SURVEY

— *Thank you!*

- \* As surveys go, a 5-30% response rate is typical: We received a response of ~30% of our households — Excellent!
- \* A strong distribution of ages were represented as well as those both newer and longer-term as parishioners, school parents, and those affiliated with the school over the years.

- ⇒ **IMPROVING THE FLOORING AND WALLS.**  
The elements of a church are meant to speak to the beauty of the liturgy and also the church as a symbol of heaven.
- ⇒ **MAKING THE CHURCH INTERIOR MORE A PLACE APART FROM THE WORLD OUTSIDE.** The interior of a church should provide a sanctuary, a place of peace, joy and closeness to God — a place for us to step away from the busyness and distractions of the world.
- ⇒ **ENSURING THE ENVIRONMENT IS APPEALING TO ALL GENERATIONS.** A church should offer a sense of timelessness so that regardless of a person's age, or the specific year or decade in time, the environment will speak to all and not require any significant changes in the future.
- ⇒ **PROVIDING A FAMILY-FRIENDLY OPPORTUNITY FOR QUIETING & CALMING**

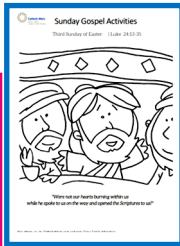

### Saint Mark the Evangelist : Episode 1



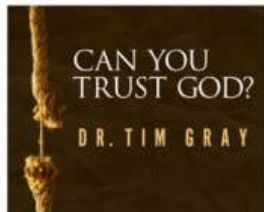

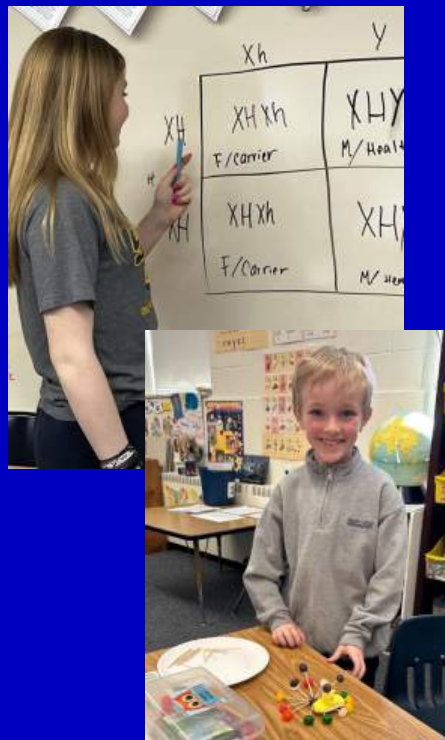
