## Wisdom From the Saints and Pope Francis on Motherhood



**St. Thérèse of Lisieux:** "The loveliest masterpiece of the heart of God is the heart of a mother."

**József Cardinal Mindszenty:** "The Most Important Person on earth is a mother. She cannot claim the honour of having built Notre Dame Cathedral. She need not. She has built something more magnificent than any cathedral—a dwelling for an immortal soul, the tiny perfection of her baby's body... The angels have not been blessed with such a grace. They cannot share in God's creative miracle to bring new saints to Heaven. Only a human mother can. Mothers are closer to God the Creator than any other creature; God joins forces with mothers in performing this act of creation... What on God's good earth is more glorious than this; to be a mother?"

**Pope St. John Paul II:** "Thank you, *women who are mothers!* You have sheltered human beings within yourselves in a unique experience of joy and travail. **Pope Francis:** "A society without mothers would be a dehumanized society, for mothers are always, even in the worst moments, witnesses of tenderness, dedication and moral strength....Dearest mothers, thank you, thank you for what you are in your family and for what you give to the Church and the world."

A friend of mine recently shared some advice which has been very helpful to me. He said, when a person reaches their 40's they come to realize that they

have been through enough of life's experiences to be able to reflect back on them and learn something from them. But when a person reaches their 50's or 60's they have to begin to make a decision. That decision is whether the person will continue to live with the *false self*, or be moved by God's grace to the *true self*.

Let me explain.

So, what do I mean by the *false self*? The false self is the part of ourselves that looks for honors, career advancement, or something that others will regard as successful. To live with the *false self* is to wear a mask, in a sense, is very concerned with what others think of them---especially those who can give them something---like people with power and wealth. The *false self* usually lives in the world of unreality and illusion and makes everything about "me".

The *true self* lives for God, tries to please God not self; gives their life to God to do whatever God wants to do with them.

For most of us, there lies within us both the false self and the true self. What we strive to do, through God's grace and life's experiences, is to more and more move away from the false self and toward the true self. But more often than not we go back and forth.

Jesus says, "if you love me you will keep my commandments." To do what Christ asks is to move toward the true self. And even though we have to face life's disappointments from time to time, God's grace can keep us moving in the right direction.

One thing to remember, Christ knows our hearts. If we persist in following the false self we can lose who we are meant to be. But if we learn from our life and its challenges, we will become better persons---more true to self. We will be doing things for the right reasons and we will be at peace with ourselves and we will not look back with regret.

God's will in our life will make more sense to us moving forward, the more we journey toward the *true self*.

## THE DESIGN, ARCHITECTURE, AND CONSTRUCTION PROCESS

A significant project, such as our potential church renovation and school expansion effort, is developed in a series of steps.

We are at the second step which considers potential designs to foster discussion on project direction.

**Pre-Design**



**Learn** = Identify needs and wants. (Completed.)

**Schematic Design**



**Explore** = Preliminary design options for discussion and modification. (In progress.)

**Design Development**

**Implement** = Finalize the design; the floor plan now identifies the final sizing and placement of each space and functional element: rooms, halls, mechanicals, plumbing, electrical, etc.

**Construction Documents**

**Finalize** = The final detailed plans and specifications to convey the functional and aesthetic aspects of the project resulting in construction documents.

**Bidding**

**Prepare** = Produce and issue documents necessary for construction contracts.

**Construction**

**Execute** = Construction.

## CHURCH INSIGHTS ON THE ROLE OF SACRED ARCHITECTURE

Christ is present in the Catholic church. The church building points to Christ's presence in sign and symbol, reflecting a house for the Church that is also the house of God on earth. It is in the church that we express and deepen our relationship with God — an eternal and timeless relationship.

“Just as Christ invited those who heard him to share his personal union with the Father through material signs, so Christ leads the Church through these same signs in the liturgy from the visible to the invisible. As a result, effective liturgical signs have a teaching function and encourage full, conscious, and active participation, express and strengthen faith, and lead people to God. Poorly utilized or minimal signs do not enliven the community's faith and can even diminish active participation. ...The liturgy and its signs and symbols do not exercise merely a teaching function. They also touch and move a person to conversion of heart and not simply to enlightenment of the mind.”

Elements of the church help to foster an ongoing exploration and enrichment of each person's faith journey and their ever-deepening relationship with Christ.

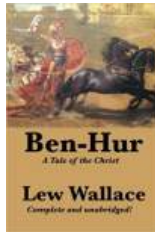

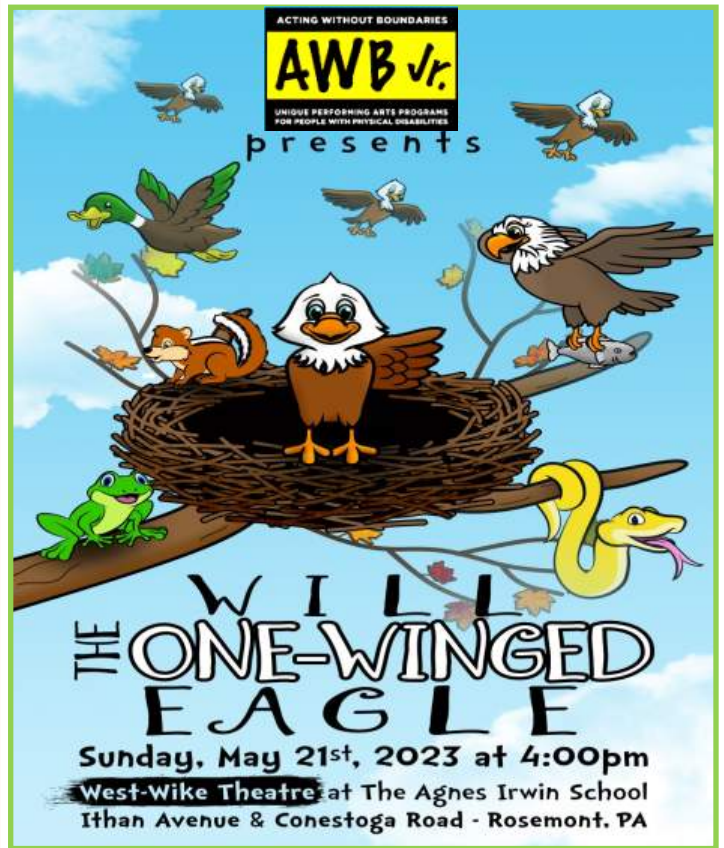
