In the early days of the church, there were many concerns over various types of heresies. And people would be willing to go to prison, or suffer worse, rather

than give in to anything that would contradict what was considered the *truth of church teaching concerning who Jesus was*.

For example, there's Saint Athanasius. He was the fourth century bishop of Alexandria, Egypt. He fought against the Arian heresy which denied the divinity of Christ. Athanasius was a staunch defender of Christ's divinity, and he did a lot to support the pope at the time and hold the true faith in place. But he suffered for it. He was imprisoned, slandered, framed, and five times he was exiled. He actually had to hide in the desert to escape being murdered!

And St. Athanasius wasn't only one, there were others as well. Many of the basics of our faith—the very beliefs that Athanasius and others defended, are contained in the Creed which we say every Sunday.

There's something that the early Church instinctively recognized that today we rarely even think about: *If our idea about God is wrong, then our idea about how to follow God and achieve salvation will also be wrong*. And if our idea of God is wrong, then it certainly effects how we interact with this God of ours. This can have an effect on how we pray—or whether or not we will even make the attempt to pray.

So, as we remember the Holy Trinity, it's important to realize that the better sense we have

of who God is, the more we can be drawn toward Him in faith and love.

The basic idea here is this: When we speak of the Trinity, we are talking about *one God, three persons—Father, Son, and Spirit*. Certainly not three Gods. And we can't compart mentalize these three persons. They are all interconnected. The other basic idea here is that this is a mystery which we will never fully understand until we get to heaven.

When we think about the Trinity it's important to see it as a dynamic interaction between Father, Son and Holy Spirit. In the Seminary we were told this: The “energy” that exists between the three persons of the Trinity is Love. The love of the Father begets the Son, and the love shared between the Father and the Son begets the Holy Spirit. Does that help to “clarify”, or does it muddy the waters for you?

If what lies at the very heart of God's essence is love, I think that can perhaps make God more approachable. Not to say that our God is a big push-over, but we can start to realize that this love extends to us.

Would we be willing to go to prison for our faith? How much of this faith of ours, and our understanding of who God is for us would we be willing to defend? If God is for us something—or someone significant, then our professed love for God has to manifest itself in *how we live our life*. So, as we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity, we take the opportunity to clarify in our own minds who this God is for us. Is my idea of God wrong? Pray for the grace to better understand.

Based on your input from our survey in March, our community believes there is an opportunity to improve our worship & educational spaces.

We got to work. In a Planning Study, conducted in May, we shared early concept drawings to facilitate a conversation about ways to approach these two possible projects. It also explored conducting a major fundraising campaign to support them.

Nearly 25% of all SJN households responded (a strong response).

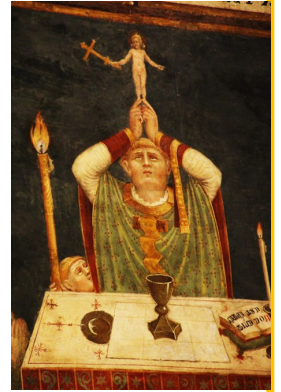
## Why Thomas Aquinas believed the Eucharist is Jesus : One of the poems he wrote in honor of Corpus Christi explains the reason for his faith.

St. Thomas Aquinas wrote five beautiful hymns to the Eucharist at the request of Pope Urban VI, who established the feast of Corpus Christi in 1264.

Various translations exist for his hymn *Adoro Te Devote*, written in Latin.

The verse rendered below, in three different translations, emphasizes how God, Truth himself, simply cannot utter untruth.

Perhaps an analogy can help us think about this: a hot fire simply cannot put off a cool breeze. Therefore, what God has told us can be believed, even when the senses of touch and seeing “tell” us something different.



Enliven your faith by meditating with this verse:

**Not to sight, or taste, or touch be credit.  
Hearing only do we trust secure;  
I believe, for God the Son has said it —  
Word of truth that ever shall endure.**

**Seeing, touching, tasting are in Thee deceived:  
How says trusty hearing? That shall be believed;  
What God's Son has told me, take for truth I do;  
Truth Himself speaks truly or there's nothing true.**

**Sight, touch, and taste in Thee are each deceived;  
The ear alone most safely is believed:  
I believe all the Son of God has spoken,  
Than Truth's own word there is no truer token.**

## What is the History of the Sacred Heart Devotion?

The foundation for the Sacred Heart devotion began in early Christianity. Sacred Scripture, particularly the New Testament, mentions the love of God many times, and the Church Fathers discuss God's love as well.

In the eleventh century, Christians often meditated on the Five Wounds of Jesus, and the specific devotion to the Sacred Heart came from this meditation. St. Gertrude the Great, who had private revelations regarding the Sacred Heart, helped further the understanding of Jesus' Sacred Heart in the late 13th-century.

Several centuries later, in 1670, St. John Eudes celebrated the first Feast of the Sacred Heart. In 1673, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a French Visitation nun, received her own revelations, in which Jesus explained His love for all people, even allowing St. Margaret to lay her head on His Heart, as He had also allowed St. Gertrude to do. He asked that Catholics receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays of the month and adore Him in the Holy Eucharist.

In 1675, Jesus told St. Margaret that He wanted an annual feast in honor of His Sacred Heart. In 1856, Blessed Pope Pius IX designated that the Feast of the Sacred Heart would be celebrated universally on the Friday after the Corpus Christi octave each year.

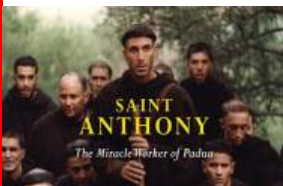

*June 13: St Anthony of Padua, Priest and Doctor of the Church (1195-1231)*

*Why is St. Anthony the patron saint of lost items?*

We often turn to St. Anthony of Padua when we've lost something—but why? Where did this well-known patronage originate? It goes back to a time when St. Anthony himself lost something very precious.

A Franciscan who lived in the 13th century, St. Anthony was a particularly gifted teacher and preacher. He owned a psalter (a book of the Psalms) that was very dear to him. Before the invention of the printing press, books in general were precious since they had to be copied out by hand.



Additionally, St. Anthony had made many notes for his sermons and classes in the pages of his copy. It was invaluable to his work, and when it disappeared one day, he was grieved by its loss. He prayed fervently that it would be found.

Turns out, an unhappy novice had decided to leave the religious life and, when he had departed the monastery, had taken St. Anthony's psalter with him! After the saint's prayers, the novice not only returned the psalter, but also returned to the religious life. The actual psalter is said to be housed at a Franciscan friary in Bologna, Italy.

St. Anthony is now known both as the finder of lost items—and of lost souls! Be sure to invoke his aid if you have misplaced something, or if you have a friend or relative who needs some guidance back to the right path.
