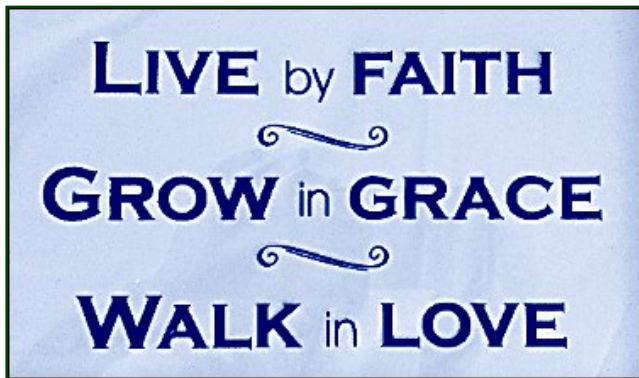

Sometimes we find ourselves in “impossible” situations. It can be a difficulty with your teenage son or daughter, a husband suffering from an addiction, a wife

whose battling with depression, family drama about how to handle an aging parent, or other family member. Perhaps it involves a friend, a situation at work, or other circumstance where you find yourself throwing your hands up in despair.

We call these situations *impossible* for a reason—they’re not easily resolved. And it seems that there’s no end in sight—no relief.

My intention in mentioning these kinds of things is not to be gloomy. I certainly do believe in miracles—that with God nothing is impossible. *But there are those times when we pray, we offer help, and nothing happens.* I think these are the situations that Jesus is addressing in the scene portrayed in Matthew’s Gospel.

So, here’s the best way to sum up the message: *When dealing with what seems impossible situations, do your best and leave the rest to God.*

Here’s another little scenario:

A guy who lost his young wife a year ago to cancer is now trying to deal with a rebellious daughter who has gotten herself pregnant. The girl is immature and is just expecting her father to take the responsibility of raising the child. The daughter is not saying that directly, but the father knows that’s what’s going to end up happening.



The father is trying to help the daughter face reality, and this is not going over too well. The daughter keeps saying that she wishes her mother were still alive, that she would understand better. The father is trying to do his best in what seems at the time to be an impossible situation.

You might ask: How do I know if I’m doing my best? Well, have you tried to talk to the other person? Have you sought the advice of others? Have you asked God to help you? Have you even considered bringing God into the situation *at all*?

You also have to remember that *many of these kinds of situations are not of your own making. Don’t blame yourself or place the burden completely on yourself to figure out how to fix it.* You do your best and leave the rest to God. You learn this prayer and say it to yourself many times throughout the course of the day: *Jesus, I give myself to you. Take care of everything.* Say it many times and let it sink in!

And really leave it to God. Learn to take God seriously! Don’t grind about the situation and get angry and frustrated, or allow yourself to be filled with resentment. Don’t make yourself miserable over what’s going on, and try not to become fearful of the future. At the same time, don’t run away and try to hide from the situation and pretend all is fine when you know it isn’t.

Finally, trust that God will not abandon you. Keep praying and know that God has some greater purpose that someday you will fully understand.

**SAINTS ANDREW KIM TAEGON, PAUL CHONG HASANG, AND COMPANIONS (FEAST SEPT. 20)**



Today we remember a whole group of courageous Korean Christians—113 martyrs canonized together in 1984. Among them were Andrew, a 21-year-old priest; Paul, a 45-year-old seminarian; Columba Kim, a 26-year-old single woman, and her sister Agnes; and Peter Ryau, a 13-year-old boy. Some 10,000 Catholics were martyred for their faith before religious freedom came to Korea in 1884.

Today Korea has nearly 4 million Catholics. During a Japanese invasion in 1592, a small number of Koreans were baptized. Soon after, Korea cut itself off from the rest of the world. Around 1777, some Confucian scholars decided to follow Christ after reading books brought into the country by Catholics from China.

When a Chinese priest secretly arrived about 12 years later, he found 4,000 Catholics who had never seen a priest. Korea's first Christian community was made up entirely of laypeople! Between 1839 and 1867, there were fierce persecutions. One hundred three members of this community were martyred with three bishops and seven priests from the Paris Foreign Mission Society.

Andrew Kim Taegon was the first native Korean priest. He was the son of converts. His father, a farmer, was also martyred. Andrew was baptized when he was 15. He then attended the seminary in Macao, China, 1,300 miles away from home. After six years Andrew returned to Korea and assumed the job of bringing missionaries into the country secretly. Almost immediately he was arrested, tortured, and beheaded.

In a letter written to fellow Christians, Andrew stated, "We have received baptism, entrance into the Church, and the honor of being called Christians. Yet what good will this do us if we are Christians in name only and not in fact?"

The **Anointing of the Sick** is one of the seven Catholic sacraments.

In the essential rite of the sacrament, the priest lays his hands on the sick person's head. Then he anoints the person on the forehead and palms of the hands with the oil of the sick, a holy oil that has been blessed by the bishop.

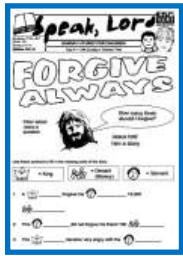
Lord, make me an instrument of your peace.

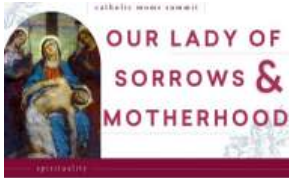

### The Reluctant Saint: The Story of St. Joseph Cupertino



This film portrays the life of St. Joseph of Cupertino, the humble Franciscan-friar who literally rose to sainthood. Joseph's peasant mother convinces the

reluctant abbot to accept her son into the monastery. With the support of the kindly local bishop who sees in him a great deal more than others do, and by a series of miraculous incidents, the simple but pious Joseph is ordained a priest.

### Sep. 21: St. Matthew, Apostle and Evangelist

Matthew was a Jew who worked for the occupying Roman forces, collecting taxes from other Jews. The Romans were not scrupulous about what the "tax farmers" got for themselves. Hence the latter, known as "publicans," were generally hated as traitors by their fellow Jews. The Pharisees lumped them with "sinners" (see Matthew 9:11-13). So it was shocking to them to hear Jesus call such a man to be one of his intimate followers. Matthew got Jesus in further trouble by having a sort of going-away party at his house. The Gospel tells us that many tax collectors and "those known as sinners" came to the dinner. The Pharisees were still more badly shocked. What business did the supposedly great teacher have associating with such immoral people? Jesus' answer was, "Those who are well do not need a physician, but the sick do. Go and learn the meaning of the words, 'I desire mercy, not sacrifice.' I did not come to call the righteous but sinners" (Matthew 9:12b-13). Jesus is not setting aside ritual and worship; he is saying that loving others is even more important.



From such an unlikely situation, Jesus chose one of the foundations of the Church, a man others, judging from his job, thought was not holy enough for the position. But Matthew was honest enough to admit that he was one of the sinners Jesus came to call. He was open enough to recognize truth when he saw him. "And he got up and followed him" (Matthew 9:9b). —Source: [franciscanmedia.org/](http://franciscanmedia.org/)

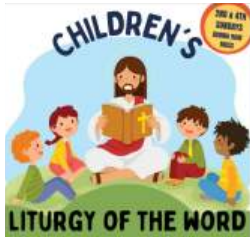
