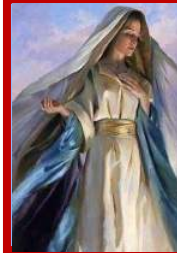

# Retirement Fund for Religious

St. Theodosius was a monk who lived in Palestine in the 500's. After growing in holiness himself, he decided to start a new monastery, which soon attracted

so many vocations that it became more of a *monastic city* than just a monastery.

One of the first things he did when he founded his monastery was rather shocking. He dug a large grave right in the middle of the cloister. When he had finished digging, the monks gathered around the rectangular pit for an explanation.

Here's what Theodosius said very simply:

"Here you see a grave. Here we will *all* one day be buried and our bodies will return to the dust from which they were made. *Remember this, my sons, so that you never stray from the Lord's sure but narrow road of prayer and self-denial.* It is better to die to ourselves each day and rise again on the Day of Judgment than to indulge ourselves foolishly *now* and remain in the grave *forever.*"

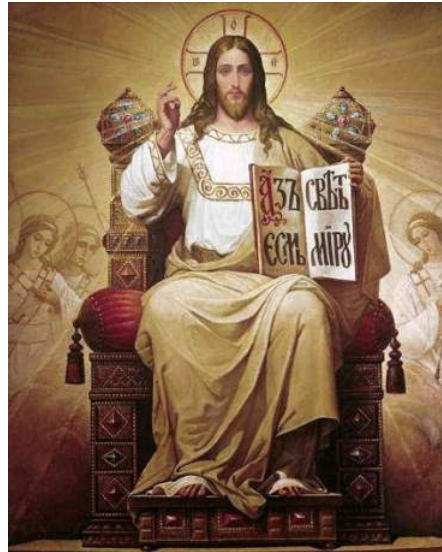
Today is a very "grand" feast day: The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Sounds pretty important, doesn't it! Here's what Pope Pius XI, the one who founded this feast day, said about it: "The faithful, moreover, will gain much strength and courage, enabling them to form their lives after the true Christian ideal."

The true Christian ideal—something we may have watered down a little too much in our lives. And there's so much "out there" that competes with Christ's message!

In the great churches and cathedrals of Europe (and in many more traditional churches

in our own area), it would not be uncommon to see over the main entrance a painting or sculpture of The Last Judgment. After Mass, as everyone left the Church to carry on with their daily lives, they would be reminded of their long-term goal. I think that's what today is all about—reminding us of "our long-term goal". If Christ is indeed *the King* then we can't go around day after day ignoring Him. And this belief must translate into actions. Most importantly, how we treat others, especially those less fortunate than we are. We must use our gifts and talents to be of service to others.

So the irony about Christ the King is that we won't find Him in a palace, but in the person who was suffering and in need: "For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me..." Notice, Christ the King says "I". He is the one in need—that's how much the Lord identifies with those less fortunate.



The choices that we make in life matter to God. They have a lasting impact. But just as we should be mindful of the needs of the poor, we should also turn to the Lord for the healing that we need in our own life. Because Jesus is MOST KINGLY when he is on that cross, suffering and dying for our sins—and, of course, rising again!

So, although Theodosius's methods might seem a little macabre on the surface, the message is simple and clear. Jesus is the King. He wants to have an effect in our lives. We will have to answer for ourselves if we go day after day shutting Him out. Remember: "It is better to die to ourselves each day and rise again on the Day of Judgment than to indulge ourselves foolishly now and remain in the grave forever."

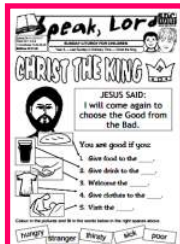
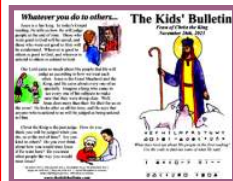
