When Jesus appears to the apostles he says to them, "Why are you troubled? And why do questions arise in your hearts?" *Why are you troubled?* This made

me think of Saint John Paul II's words when he became Pope back in 1978. At his installation Mass, instead of speaking about the culture of the time, he decided to make his words very personal and chose to go right to the heart. He said, "Be not afraid!"

As we continue to celebrate the joy of the Easter Season we need to hear these words again. Sadly, we live in a world that thinks itself very independent, self-sufficient, not needing religion or God. *But when we set God to the side, we instill in ourselves a self-reliant approach to life: we think our happiness and security in life depends all on us and how we perform. We end up constantly trying to control and manage everything, leaving us...worried and anxious about many things.*

What is being asked of us is that we grow in trust. This is so important in a life of faith that affects how we live our life from one day to the next. When Saint John Paul said, "Do not be afraid", he added to that, "Open wide the doors to Christ." In other words, let Christ into your life, don't hide anything from Him. Ask for his help.

Is there an area of your life *right now* that you have not allowed Jesus to enter? Is there something that you are dealing with that you have not *entrusted completely to God*. Maybe it's something you are worried about right now, a concern that weighs you down. Perhaps it's a hurt from your past *or some situation in the present that you are exhaustingly trying to control*. Maybe it's a part of your life where you are afraid to let Jesus in because He

might challenge you to change something or give up something. These words, then, are meant for you:

*Do not be afraid to welcome Christ and accept His power...Do not be afraid. Open wide the doors to Christ. To His saving power open the boundaries...Do not be afraid. Christ knows what is in you. He alone knows it.*

Let me leave you with FIVE key truths to remember if you want to grow in trust. (Freedom from fear can only happen when we grow in trust and surrender):

First, when we give ourselves away in love we actually gain so much more in return. This is called the Law of self-giving, where I am asked to use my life, out of love, to serve God's purposes.

Second, remember that God doesn't take everything away. He's not planning to crush all that we look forward to in life, God is just asking us to be open to what his will might be for us.

Third, *whatever we don't surrender to the Lord will cause us unnecessary stress and worry. Whatever we insist on managing and controlling by ourselves will be a constant, underlying source of agitation and unease.* So, surrender it all to Him!

Fourth, what displeases God most is when we don't trust him.

And fifth, bring God's Word into whatever may be causing you distress. Say short prayers throughout the day when you find yourself giving in to worry life "Jesus, I trust is you". This is how we fight the evil spirit who's trying to get us to lose our peace.

Finally, as an overall comment: Each day we are to practice the presence of Christ rather than practice the presence of problems.

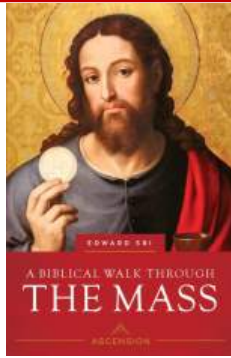

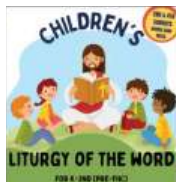
