“Jim is a saint!” Everyone who knows him said it, from his faithful and loving wife, to all his children, from people he worked with, to his friends. People especially

thought this when they saw how he handled his very rare and painful illness that he had to struggle with for almost seven years. Even while he was on hospice all those who cared for him were deeply inspired.

Jim never complained. “He was always concerned about *you*”, people would say. Those who went to visit him while he was sick felt that, in the end, he was ministering to them rather than the other way around.

Someone asked Jim how he was able to keep his faith in the face of so many challenges and he said: “Many years ago, long before I ever got sick, when I was still pretty young, I had to make a decision in my life. It concerned a big mistake that I had made. Back when all that happened I thought that my life was over and that I would never recover from what had occurred. But God wasn’t going to let go of me so easily and sent me a very holy priest who said to me,

‘Jim, you are being asked to make a decision. Do you trust in God or not? I believe that in all of this God is asking you to trust in him and to grow from this experience of fear and uncertainty. I think the Lord is looking you right in the eye and saying to you, ‘Make a choice to trust me and grow from all that you’re going through now, or live in fear and regret for the rest of your life. I will not abandon you. Believe it or not, you will see blessings from this some day. *Trust*



*in me. Really make an effort to do that’.*

And although I still had to deal with the consequences of what had happened, I really learned to pray every day, ‘Lord I surrender my life to you, take care of everything’.

So, when this illness came my way, I kept asking Jesus to help me have faith and trust—to get me through just one day at a time.

The Gospel today forces us to ask an important question: How much do I really trust in God? Am I going to abandon myself to the Lord, or do I really think that I am alone in my suffering? And we are challenged to something else, as well. We are asked to have faith in the midst of affliction.

Here’s a quote from one of Father Thomas Keating’s spiritual books that I have found to be very helpful when I am struggling during difficult times. Here’s what he wrote in a book called “Crisis of Faith, Crisis of Love”:

“God loves you very much, but do not expect that he is going to be on the job the moment you have need of him. On the contrary, he appears *not* to be on the job. But he *is* on the job more than you think. He has things all planned in the back of his mind. He feigns disinterest. He ignores you for the moment. But that is the surest sign of something really wonderful about to happen.”

So, have faith in the midst of affliction. Learn to trust Jesus. And remember what Pope Francis so beautifully says: “Faith is not a light which scatters all our darkness, but a *lamp which guides all our steps in the night and suffices for the journey.*”

### Welcome St. Thérèse of Lisieux to St. John Neumann Church!

We are excited to introduce a newly acquired lithograph of Saint Thérèse of Lisieux by Edgar Maxence (1927). This beautiful portrayal of Thérèse comes to us from St. Charles Borromeo Seminary.

St. Thérèse is depicted in her Carmelite habit, haloed, holding in a crucifix and a bouquet of white and golden roses. A rosary is also on the left. She is framed by two columns and an arch inscribed with: *Je veux passer mon ciel à faire du bien sur la Terre* (I want to spend my heaven doing good on Earth) and *Sainte Thérèse de l'Enfant-Jésus* (Saint Thérèse of the Child Jesus).



### About Saint Thérèse

Thérèse of Lisieux was a Carmelite nun, known as the Little Flower. She lived a cloistered life of obscurity in a convent. Her preference for hidden sacrifice did indeed convert souls. Few saints are more popular than this young nun. Her autobiography, *The Story of a Soul*, is read and loved throughout the world. Thérèse Martin entered the convent at the age of 15 and died in 1897 at the age of 24.

Life in a Carmelite convent is indeed uneventful and consists mainly of prayer and hard domestic work. But Thérèse possessed that holy insight that redeems the time, however dull that time may be. She saw in quiet suffering a redemptive suffering, suffering that was indeed her apostolate. Thérèse said she came to the Carmel convent “to save souls and pray for priests.” Shortly before she died, she wrote: “I want to spend my heaven doing good on earth.” Thérèse was canonized in 1925. On October 19, 1997, Pope John Paul II proclaimed her a Doctor of the Church, the third woman to be so recognized.

*Thank you Lord, I believe we are friends.*

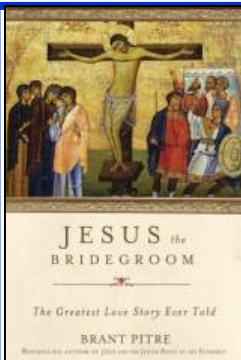
**Fr. Bill Atkinson, O.S.A.** was born in Philadelphia. He was the first quadriplegic ordained as a priest in the Roman Catholic Church. Fr. Atkinson was stationed at Monsignor Bonner High School for almost thirty years (1975-2004).

The archdiocesan phase of the cause of beatification and canonization was closed in 2021 and brought to completion the juridical inquiry into his life, virtues, and reputation of holiness and of intercessory power that began in 2015. Since then, the Archdiocese has examined historical documents, heard witness testimonies, and conducted related investigations – all for the purpose of gathering proofs in order to attain moral certitude about his life of heroic virtue.

On June 14 in a private ceremony, Fr. Bill's remains were translated and reinterred to the church of St. Thomas of Villanova on the campus of Villanova University. He was laid to rest forever in Our Mother of Good Counsel alcove. He remains in peace in perpetuity in a holy and sacred place that holds deep significance for him, the Atkinson family, the Augustinian Friars, and Villanova University.

### **Jesus the Bridegroom: The Greatest Love Story Ever Told**

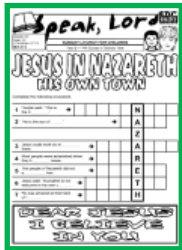

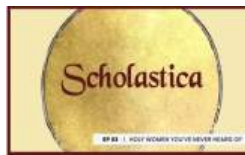

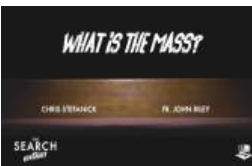
