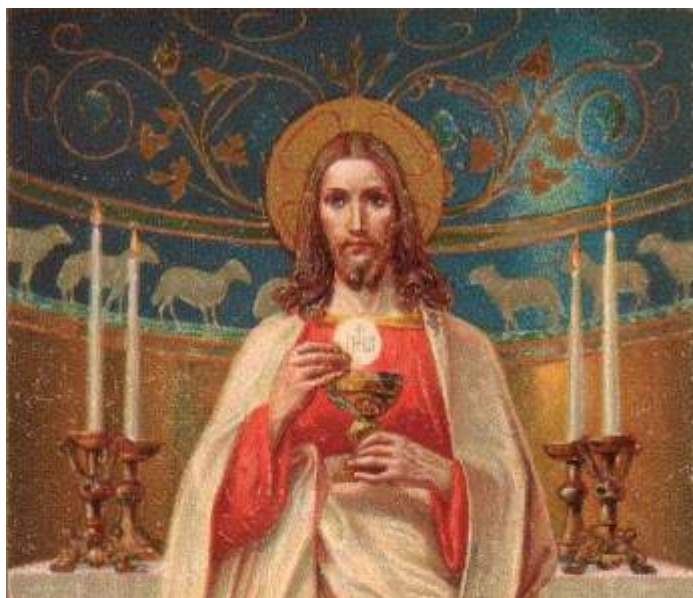

Elijah says, "This is enough, O Lord! Take my life for I am no better than my fathers." He sounds pretty distraught, doesn't he. He

had given up. And we can feel like that from time to time in our own lives. We say to ourselves, "I just can't take one more thing!"

But there was something to be done and God had chosen Elijah to do it. So those of us who are discouraged, turn to God, hang on! It's true, we don't have the strength ourselves, but God does. We are nourished by receiving Christ in the Eucharist.

So that's the first message for today: Don't give in to despair; don't give up! Rely on Jesus to give you the help and the strength you need to do what he wants you to do.

The second message is this: Don't forget your commitment to God, self and others. In John's Gospel they're trying to discredit Jesus. "Is this not Jesus, the son of Joseph? Do we not know his father and mother? Then how can he say, 'I have come down from heaven'? In other words, "Who does he think he is?" We don't have to listen to what he's saying.

How often do we see people drift away from the faith. Take some of your young people, for example. As they get older and more immersed in the culture of the world, they start to think following Jesus' message is not necessary. "I can do just fine on my own." And sadly, there are homes where there's no faith practiced at all. And this starts to have a domino effect. Don't lose your faith. When you do, and you face life's problems, you'll have nothing to rely on—nothing to get you through.

Be nourished by Jesus himself: The living bread that comes down from heaven. A Trappist monk: Dom Eugene Boylan says "There is one great difference between the Eucharistic food and ordinary food. When we receive Holy Communion, our Lord comes to us as our food. This food is rather unique. Instead of being changed into us, it changes us into itself."

Have you heard of the cross of St. Benedict? It has a unique appearance. It goes back to the 11th century. It's all about protection. There are a number of letters on the cross and around the cross. They're not words but rather each letter stands for a Latin word. Here's what it says:

May the holy cross be to me light

May the devil not be my guide

Go behind me, Satan

Do not suggest to me vain things

They are evil the things you offer

You yourself drink the poison

We all need spiritual help to navigate the complicated world in which we live. We need the nourishment found in the Eucharist. And as you are confronted with temptations say this prayer right in that moment. The evil spirit has been conquered. God will make the Devil flee.



Aug. 22: The Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Pope Pius XII established this feast in 1954. But the Blessed Virgin Mary's queenship has roots in Scripture. At the Annunciation, Gabriel announced that Mary's Son would receive the throne of David and rule forever. At the Visitation, Elizabeth calls Mary "mother of my Lord." As in all the mysteries of Mary's life, she is closely associated with Jesus: Her queenship is a share in Jesus' kingship. We can also recall that in the Old Testament the mother of the king has great influence in court.

In the fourth century Saint Ephrem called Mary "Lady" and "Queen." Later Church fathers and doctors continued to use the title. Hymns of the 11th to 13th centuries address Mary as queen: "Hail, Holy Queen," "Hail, Queen of Heaven," "Queen of Heaven." The Dominican rosary and the Franciscan Crown (rosary) as well as numerous invocations in Mary's litany celebrate her queenship.

The feast is a logical follow-up to the Assumption and is now celebrated on the octave day of that feast. In his 1954 encyclical *To the Queen of Heaven*, Pius XII points out that Mary deserves the title because she is Mother of God, because she is closely associated as the New Eve with Jesus' redemptive work, because of her preeminent perfection, and because of her intercessory power.

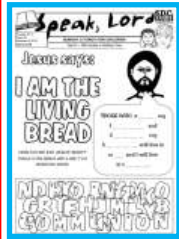

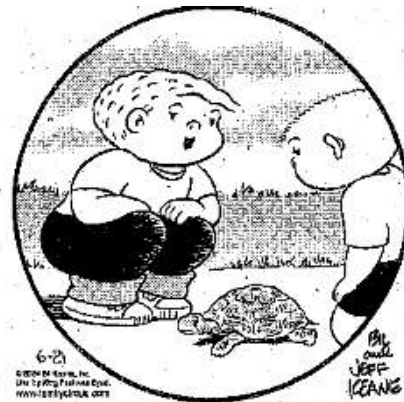
