In Mark's gospel Jesus says to his disciples: "The Son of Man is to be handed over to men and they will kill him and three days after his death

the Son of Man will rise." The disciples really didn't understand the meaning of this, but they were afraid to question Jesus. Then the scene changes.

Jesus and the disciples have arrived at Capernaum and Jesus asks: "What were you arguing about on the way?" *But they remained silent.* Interesting. It's almost as if they got caught doing something wrong. Perhaps they didn't want Jesus to know what they had been arguing about. But of course Jesus does know what they were arguing about. The disciples thought that what they were doing was hidden, *but it wasn't!* When Jesus asked them what they had been arguing about, they had nothing to say. This leads us to consider something very important, what William Barclay, a classic Scripture scholar, referred to as *the silence of shame.*

Here's what Barclay means by this: If we took everything and set it in the sight of Jesus, it would make all the difference in

the world. If of everything we did, we asked, "Could I go on doing this if Jesus was watching me?" If of everything we said, we asked, "Could I go on talking like this if Jesus was listening to me?" There would be many things which we would be saved from doing and saying. And the fact of Christian belief is that there is no 'if' about it. All deeds are done, all words are spoken in His Presence. God keeps us from the words and deeds which we would be ashamed that He should hear and see.

Very often in life our fears and lack of knowledge or understanding can lead to chaos, confusion, and perhaps even harsh judgement of others. Perhaps it was the disciples' fears and lack of understanding that led them to the wrong way of thinking and then to arguing with each other over something that, in the end, really had no importance from Jesus' perspective anyway.

So, don't let your fears or lack of understanding cause confusion in your life. See things as Jesus would want you to see them and allow the Lord to lead you on the right path toward salvation!



Our heavenly Father shows his love for us by taking care of us as we make our way here below. In addition to all that we receive through the ministry of the Church, we enjoy the help of the saints, those holy men and women who have preceded us, in heaven. Still more, he also gives each person one of his holy angels to be a spiritual companion and guide. We call upon our guardian angels with devotion and gratitude so that one day we may "Look upon the face of the heavenly Father" with them.

In the essential rite of the sacrament, the priest lays his hands on the sick person's head. Then he anoints the person on the forehead and palms of the hands with the oil of the sick, a holy oil that has been blessed by the bishop.



One does not need to be in a critical state of health to receive this sacrament.

### Oct. 1: St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus (1873-1897)



"I prefer the monotony of obscure sacrifice to all ecstasies. To pick up a pin for love can convert a soul."

These are the words of Thérèse of Lisieux, a Carmelite nun called the "Little Flower," who lived a cloistered life of obscurity in the convent of Lisieux, France. And her preference for hidden sacrifice did indeed convert souls. Few saints of God are more popular than this young nun. Her autobiography, *The Story of a Soul*, is read and loved throughout the world. Thérèse Martin entered the convent at the age of 15 and died in 1897 at the age of 24. She was canonized in 1925.

Of you, Most High, he bears the likeness.

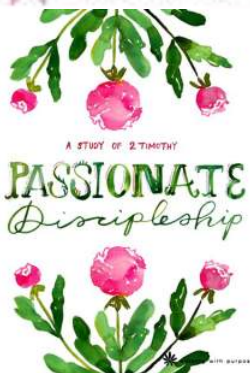

**The Man Who Helped Fr. Bill Atkinson,**  
**Miracle Priest**

Steve McWilliams' and Fr. Bill Atkinson's lives were intertwined for decades...

On February 22, 1965, the toboggan in which Bill Atkinson was riding hit a tree, leaving him almost completely paralyzed from the neck down. Undaunted, he continued his studies to become a priest with the help of family and friends, including Steve McWilliams, a member of the faculty at Villanova University. Nine years after the accident, Bill petitioned St. Paul VI to be ordained a priest in the Augustinian Order. On Feb. 2, 1974, Father Bill became the first quadriplegic priest to be ordained. Today, 18 years after his death in 2006, Fr. Bill is one step closer in the cause for canonization.

Steve served as an aide to Father Bill for more than two decades. In his book, "Green Bananas: The Wisdom of Father Bill Atkinson," Steve chronicles Father Bill's incredible life story.

He has also given personal testimony to the tribunal created to investigate Fr. Bill's eligibility for consideration for canonization. Until his retirement from Villanova, Steve McWilliams, PhD, produced and directed students in the University's Social Justice Documentary film course. In addition, he served as Director of Disability Services, advising students living with disabilities, for which he and his team received the "One Body in Christ" Award from the Archdiocese of Philadelphia's Office for Persons with Disabilities & Deaf Apostolate.
