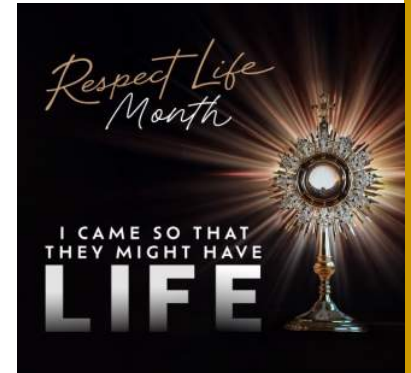

Mark was a Communion Minister. He and his wife Susan had been CM's for several years. But Susan hadn't exercised her ministry for a

long time now. She's been suffering from medical problems for more years than she cared to remember—one thing after another. What was really difficult for Susan was that she wasn't able to get to Mass on Sundays anymore. She tried to go last month but it was just too difficult.

One Saturday evening, Mark was driving home from church. As he stopped at a red light, he felt his coat pocket to make sure that the pyx was there. Yes. It was. He was bringing Holy Communion to his wife. He felt honored to be able to do this. And he knew Susan was grateful to be receiving the Body of Christ.

As he was going through the Communion Service with Susan before their dinner, he thought to himself, "Our marriage has certainly played out very differently than I thought it would." And as he looked at his wife sitting in the recliner, after a particularly difficult day, he said to himself, "But I wouldn't change one thing. Susan, I love you more than ever."

Then Mark remembered the words of an old priest friend of his. Fr. Ed had said to him one time, after Mark and Susan had had a big fight over something—he can't even remember what it was now, "Remember those vows you took on your wedding day—'for better, for worse'. Well, the "worse" or "bad times" is usually the best teacher. And Mark had said at the time, "Well that doesn't sound too encourag-



ing!" Fr. Ed said, "the 'worst' or 'bad times' are going to teach you what God wants you to do for others—for Susan.

Now, after nearly 50 years of marriage, Mark could say that Fr. Ed's words were true. And one of the greatest obstacles that Mark had to face in the early years of his marriage and his career was coming to the realization that it wasn't all about him, and that he had to let go of his preconceived notions of what he thought his life and his marriage would be like. Mark had to learn that his happiness wasn't going to come from success as the world sees success, but as God sees it.

As the years went by and challenges were faced, Mark began to realize that God was purifying him so that he could fulfill the purpose that *God* had in mind. At first it was hard to let go, but he started to see that what God was offering him was more "valuable" than anything he had hoped or wished for himself.

Jesus says in very blunt terms, get rid of the things that would prevent you from doing my will: "Cut it off", "pluck it out", even if it's something that *you* think you really need or want. I'm going to teach you that life is not about living for yourself but about *other*. And so, we pray that

God will help us to see what it is that he wants us to do with our life. We pray for the grace to be able to live for others and to allow our challenges and our weaknesses to be the "best teacher" for us—to allow God's grace to work through them to make us whole and give us Life.

**SJN Adult Group Presents**  
**The Man Who Helped Fr. Bill Atkinson,**  
**Miracle Priest**

**Thursday, October 24, 2024**

**Steve McWilliams' and Fr. Bill Atkinson's**  
**lives were intertwined for decades...**

On February 22, 1965, the toboggan in which Bill Atkinson was riding hit a tree, leaving him almost completely paralyzed from the neck down. Undaunted, he continued his studies to become a priest with the help of family and friends, including Steve McWilliams, a member of the faculty at Villanova University. Nine years after the accident, Bill petitioned St. Paul VI to be ordained a priest in the Augustinian Order. On Feb. 2, 1974, Father Bill became the first quadriplegic priest to be ordained. Today, 18 years after his death in 2006, Fr. Bill is one step closer in the cause for canonization.

Steve served as an aide to Father Bill for more than two decades. In his book, “Green Bananas: The Wisdom of Father Bill Atkinson,” Steve chronicles Father Bill's incredible life story.

He has also given personal testimony to the tribunal created to investigate Fr. Bill's eligibility for consideration for canonization. Until his retirement from Villanova, Steve McWilliams, PhD, produced and directed students in the University's Social Justice Documentary film course. In addition, he served as Director of Disability Services, advising students living with disabilities, for which he and his team received the “One Body in Christ” Award from the Archdiocese of Philadelphia's Office for Persons with Disabilities & Deaf Apostolate.

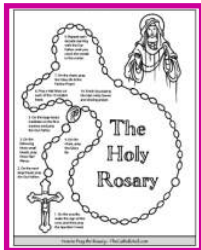

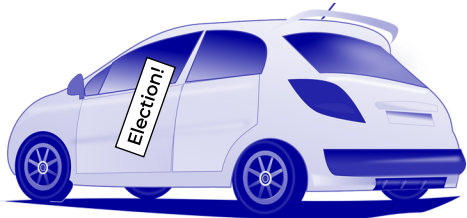

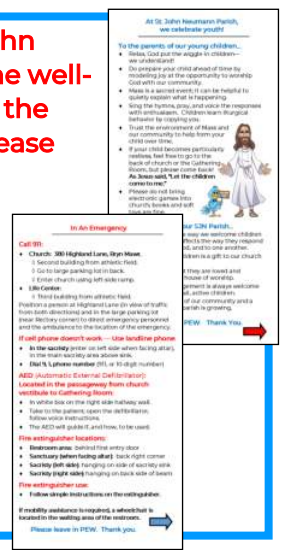
