When we read the 3rd chapter of Luke's Gospel, we might get the sense that there's too much information. Do we really need

to know the names of all these imperial and religious leaders? Do we need to know all these geographical locations? Well, actually, there is a helpful purpose here. We see the importance of history in the story of Christianity. John the Baptist's appearance occurred at a particular moment in history. God's plan of salvation manifested itself in Christ at a particular time that was of God's choosing!

John the Baptist was preaching a message of repentance but also was preaching a message of hope. Salvation was to be in Jesus Christ.

And the fullness of life that our Savior brings is both fully dependent on him, who is willing and able to be involved in our lives, and also fully dependent on us. Let me offer an illustration:

It's like a man stuck in a deep, dark pit. It's too tall for him to reach the top and lift himself out. The walls are too smooth for him to find handholds and footholds to clamber up and out. He is helpless in the bottom of the pit. He needs someone to throw him a rope or lower him a long ladder. But even if someone lowers the ladder, the man will only be saved if he freely chooses to step onto it and climb up out of the pit. The ladder will do him no good unless he uses it.

We are that man, and the pit is this fallen world that has been darkened and separated from God by original sin and our personal sins. Jesus himself is the ladder that God the Father lowers down to us. But even though God has given us a Savior, we have to freely choose to welcome him, to listen to him, to obey him. That means seeking forgiveness for our sins and letting go of our self-centered way of looking at things. We must move away from the habits of selfishness that block our progress up the ladder of salvation.

But John the Baptist's message from the desert—the message of Advent—is one that should give up hope. The images like the winding road being made straight, the rough road being made smooth, the valleys filled and the mountains lowered—all images to remind us that Christ will clear the path for us, free us from our sins—get us out of the pit where we often see ourselves, stuck there with no way out.



Jesus during this season of Advent is throwing down to us a long ladder. Will we choose to make use of it? That's the decision that each of us has to make.

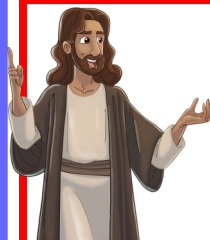


HOPE FOR STRUGGLING MARRIAGES
