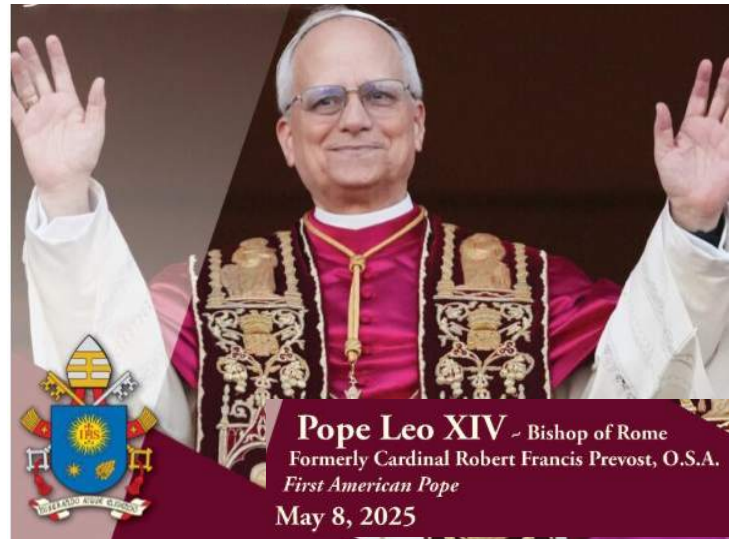

Jeff, a single person, was a hard worker. He was good at his job. Jeff wasn't interested in status or titles, so he didn't play up to the

people he reported to. For whatever reason he didn't trust them. They pretended to be for the customer, but they were more about promoting themselves and getting ahead in the company. Jeff was trying hard not to be judgmental, but his gut told him: when around sharks, be careful.

An incident occurred which confirmed his feelings. There was an employee that wasn't doing his job—he was "playing games" concerning what he did or didn't do. Jeff's assistant brought the matter to his attention. Jeff acted on it. Everything was handled carefully, and the employee was let go.

But then the employee went to the company mediation board. Jeff and his assistant had definitely crossed all the t's and dotted the i's. But right before they went to the board, Jeff and some others were called to a special meeting. It seemed as though some of the employees were looking into forming a union and the company wanted no part of it. As Jeff listened, he heard something that sounded like this: the mediation board always made sure that the employees won 50% of the time. That way they couldn't say that they needed a union since most cases went to the employee's favor.

So, when Jeff and his assistant went before the board they knew that they didn't stand a chance. When the verdict came through against them, Jeff actually prayed to God about the situation and decided to ask for a transfer to another de-

partment. These supervisors were angry at this and refused it.

The second year came. Jeff really prayed to God again about what to do. It so happened that a coworker heard that there was an opening in another department because someone had health issues. He also had a friend on the personnel committee. That friend actually made a proposal that Jeff be transferred there. The bosses actually were looking at this as a 'nothing kind of move', or you might say a lateral move. Because they didn't like him they were fine with this.

But the unexpected happened. What was thought to be a dead-end job was turned into something great and vibrant. About a year into this, Jeff had some time to think, and he reflected on what had happened in his life over this past year. He thought that he had prayed for a new position and God had heard his prayer, even though his superiors weren't supporting him. But if it weren't for the board playing games trying to make sure they balanced the number of their losses against doing what was right, then Jeff wouldn't have received the transfer into a situation that he grew to love and prosper in.

This is a true story based on what happened to a guy I know. And through this story I would like you to know that *God can work through even your enemies*. So just because you are going through something and you see nothing but the negative, my advice would be to imitate Jeff. Pray, and pray with courage. Ask God to bring you out okay at the end.

Like the men in the first reading and like Jeff, you might find out that God works through the good and sometimes even blesses us through the bad in our lives.



**May 20: St. Bernardine of Siena, Priest (1380-1444)**

St. Bernardine of Siena was a dynamic Franciscan preacher who lived from 1380 to 1444. When he was 20, he gathered a group of men to help him volunteer at a hospital during the plague. From this experience of service, Bernardine decided to join the Franciscans. After initially spending his time as a religious in solitude, he felt called to preach. He became known as one of the most influential preachers in his day. Whereas most preachers would read off a script, Bernardine would preach directly to the experiences of the everyday life of people. As part of his preaching, he promoted devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus, especially through designing the "IHS" symbol which is still depicted in art to this day.

**May 21: St. Christopher Magallanes and Companions**

St. Christopher Magallanes and companions lived in Mexico in the early twentieth century under an anti-Catholic government. Because the government had closed seminaries, churches, and schools, St. Christopher Magallanes and his fellow priests had to minister in secret. Christopher even secretly established a seminary in Jalisco. Over 22 years, throughout 8 Mexican states, Christopher, 21 other diocesan priests, and 3 lay people were martyred by the government for their Catholicism. His last words were "I am innocent and I die innocent. I forgive with all my heart those responsible for my death, and I ask God that the shedding of my blood serve the peace of our divided Mexico." The group of martyrs was beatified in 1992, and canonized by Pope St. John Paul II in 2000.

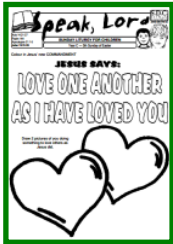

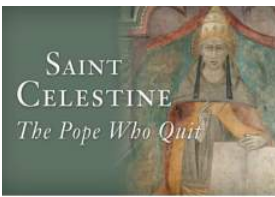

**May 22: St. Rita of Cascia, Religious (1381-1457)**

Like Elizabeth Ann Seton, Rita of Cascia was a wife, mother, widow, and member of a religious community. Her holiness was reflected in each phase of her life.

Born at Roccaporena in central Italy, Rita wanted to become a nun but was pressured at a young age into marrying a harsh and cruel man. During her 18-year marriage, she bore and raised two sons. After her husband was killed in a brawl and her sons had died, Rita tried to join the Augustinian nuns in Cascia. Unsuccessful at first because she was a widow, Rita eventually succeeded.

Over the years, her austerity, prayerfulness, and charity became legendary. When she developed wounds on her forehead, people quickly associated them with the wounds from Christ's crown of thorns. She meditated frequently on Christ's passion. Her care for the sick nuns was especially loving. She also counseled lay people who came to her monastery.

Beatified in 1626, Rita was not canonized until 1900. She has acquired the reputation, together with Saint Jude, as a saint of impossible cases. Many people visit her tomb each year.

Although we can easily imagine an ideal world in which to live out our baptismal vocation, such a world does not exist. An "If only ...." approach to holiness never quite gets underway, never produces the fruit that God has a right to expect. Rita became holy because she made choices that reflected her baptism and her growth as a disciple of Jesus. Her overarching, lifelong choice was to cooperate generously with God's grace, but many small choices were needed to make that happen. Few of those choices were made in ideal circumstances—not even when Rita became an Augustinian nun.
