Whenever Mark heard the name Sam Richards, he could feel himself getting all tense. His blood pressure would start rising.

(And Sam had been dead for three years now.)

Mark would love to tell others the story of how Sam had stabbed him in the back. Mark was in charge of a branch office of a large organization. Sam was in the central administration. Technically Sam was the boss, but he had several assistants that people like Mark would have to deal with, and they would always run interference for Sam.

It all began with Mark hearing rumors that Sam Richards wanted to close down the branch office that Mark was running. Mark would hear this from people in the company who were out to dinner with Sam Richards---or a similar kind of setting---and they would tell Mark What they had heard. Or people would say they had been hearing rumors that this was in the works. Yet Sam never said a word to Mark. There was just one time when a guy by the name of Steve who worked on the same floor as Sam one day told Mark that he knew that Sam was gunning to shut down Mark's office. The few times that Mark was in Sam's presence, like the big corporate Christmas party, Sam treated Mark like he was his new best friend.

Nevertheless, within the year, Mark's office was closed down, and it was one of Sam's subordinates that had to tell him. They offered Mark

another position, but he was so angry he quit and found a job somewhere else which actually ended up being a better environment for him to work in. He felt that these people were more genuine, and they made him feel that what he was doing was important. Yet, for some reason Mark couldn't let go of what was done to him in his previous job, and all these years later, he still felt hatred and anger toward Sam Richards.

St. Stephen was murdered---stoned to death---for what he believed. As he's being wounded by those nasty rocks, here's what he says out loud: "Lord, do not hold this against them." He forgave these people, even as they were killing him. Stephen was so strong in his faith that he trusted in what Jesus said and didn't falter in his faith.

We are asked to forgive. But we know how hard that can be. And maybe the wounds we are dealing with are more severe than the ones that might come from a difficult work situation. Yet we are asked to still try our best and let go of the anger and resentment.

So if the name of a particular person still makes you tense up and gets your blood boiling, do what Christ commanded. Say a prayer for that person. You don't have to take them out to lunch, just leave them in the Lord's hands, and free yourself of the trap of anger and cynicism. Free yourself and let God do the judging.



Hello! My name is Deacon Alexander Cross, and I have been sent to St. John Neuman for my assignment as a transitional deacon. I am a native of Souderton and a member of St. Agnes Parish in Sellersville. I am the middle of three siblings, having an older brother and a younger sister. After graduating from Souderton Area High School, I attended the University of Pittsburgh, receiving an undergraduate degree in Chemical Engineering. It was a result of my time at the University of Pittsburgh that I discerned God's call to the priesthood and entered seminary. While I was a freshman, I was invited on a camping trip with the Newman Center on campus. This in turn helped me to greater participation in the sacraments and a more robust prayer life. Eventually, through altar serving, time spent in adoration and spiritual direction, I felt called to the diocesan priesthood. I entered St. Charles Seminary in August 2019 and will start my 7th year of seminary this fall. God willing, I will be ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia in May 2026. I will be with you for the summer, along with Thursdays and weekends during the school year. I am very excited to be with you!

### June 13: St. Anthony of Padua



The gospel call to leave everything and follow Christ was the rule of Saint Anthony of Padua's life. Over and over again, God called him to something new in his plan. Every time Anthony responded with renewed zeal and self-sacrificing to serve his Lord Jesus more completely.

His journey as the servant of God began as a very young man when he decided to join the Augustinians in Lisbon, giving up a future of wealth and power to be a servant of God. Later when the bodies of the first Franciscan martyrs went through the Portuguese city where he was stationed, he was again filled with an intense longing to be one of those closest to Jesus himself: those who die for the Good News.

So Anthony entered the Franciscan Order and set out to preach to the Moors. But an illness prevented him from achieving that goal. He went to Italy and was stationed in a small hermitage where he spent most of his time praying, reading the Scriptures and doing menial tasks. The call of God came again at an ordination where no one was prepared to speak. The humble and obedient Anthony hesitantly accepted the task. The years of searching for Jesus in prayer, of reading sacred Scripture and of serving him in poverty, chastity, and obedience had prepared Anthony to allow the Spirit to use his talents. Anthony's sermon was astounding to those who expected an unprepared speech and knew not the Spirit's power to give people words.

Recognized as a great man of prayer and a great Scripture and theology scholar, Anthony became the first friar to teach theology to the other friars. Soon he was called from that post to preach to the Albigensians in France, using his profound knowledge of Scripture and theology to convert and reassure those who had been misled by their denial of Christ's divinity and of the sacraments. After he led the friars in northern Italy for three years, he made his headquarters in the city of Padua. He resumed his preaching and began writing sermon notes to help other preachers. In the spring of 1231 Anthony withdrew to a friary at Camposampiero where he had a sort of treehouse built as a hermitage. There he prayed and prepared for death.

On June 13, he became very ill and asked to be taken back to Padua, where he died after receiving the last sacraments. Anthony was canonized less than a year later and named a Doctor of the Church in 1946.

## Let's Sing with the Pope



The Vatican's Sacred Music School is helping Catholics around the world sing ancient Gregorian chant through a new initiative called "Let's Sing with the Pope." Inspired by Pope Leo XIV's recent singing of the Regina Coeli from the balcony of St. Peter's Square, the Pontifical Institute of Sacred Music, in collaboration with the Dicastery for Communication, is producing short educational video tutorials on social media. The goal is to help the faithful actively participate in liturgical celebrations with the Holy Father. Fr. Robert Mehlhart, OP, who leads the project, teaches viewers how to read and sing simple notes while explaining the meaning of the Latin texts. With nearly one million views in just one week, the response has been overwhelming. This initiative seeks to glorify God through song, and even non-believers are being moved by it; as one commenter wrote, "Father you made an atheist sing with the pope."
