There's a story of a woman who had been used to every luxury and to all respect. She died, and when she arrived in heaven, an angel

was sent to conduct her to her house. They passed many lovely mansions and the woman thought that each one, as they came to it, must be the one allotted to her. When they had passed through the main streets they came to the outskirts where the houses were much smaller; and on the very fringe they came to a house which was little more than a hut. "That is your house," said the conducting angel. "What," said the woman, "that! I cannot live in that." "I am sorry," said the angel, "but this is all that we could build for you with the materials you sent up."

This little story brings us to the final verse of the Gospel passage we just heard from St. Luke: "For behold, some are last who will be first, and some are first who will be last."

But, actually, there's much more to consider when we reflect on Jesus' response to the question asked of him: "Will only a few people be saved?"

Jesus' answer is, of course, indirect and more complicated than probably what the person asking the question was expecting. The typical expected response probably would have had something to do with the idea that all Jewish people going to heaven, and that all gentiles were NOT going to heaven. So, when Jesus says, "Strive to enter through the narrow gate," this must have come as a shock. Jesus was actually saying to this person: Your concern should be *for*

your own salvation because the path of salvation is not easy. And also, and this is connected to the little story I told, what you do or don't do in this life has an effect on what comes after.

Notice the verb Jesus used: *strive*. There's the implication that this path will involve a struggle. Entering the Kingdom of Heaven is not automatic. And in this life, we have to be mindful of our behavior and of the decisions that we make. Are we trying to follow the Gospel message in our life, or are we falling back on thinking that everyone automatically goes to heaven?

We are asked to do our best each day and to seek God's help and also his forgiveness when we have sinned. We must remember that what we do here on earth will have an effect on what happens to us in the afterlife. We can't just presume on God's mercy and then continue to do as we please or refuse to accept the opportunities the Lord offers us to be transformed.

In the Letter to the Hebrews we are also reminded not to get discouraged as we *strive to enter the narrow gate*. "So strengthen your drooping hands and your weak knees. Make straight paths for your feet, that what is lame may not be disjointed but healed."

The healing that is offered to us, comes most especially, through the Sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation). So, the appropriate response to this message from today's readings is to move toward the path of *repentance* and allow Christ to transform you and heal you. Work hard, strive to change your ways (with God's help, of course) so that you can faithfully strive toward your salvation.

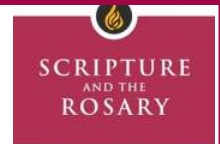

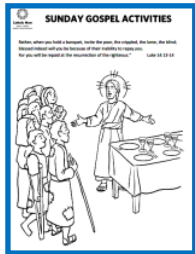

Mother Teresa: No Greater Love

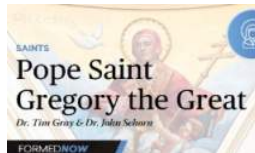
