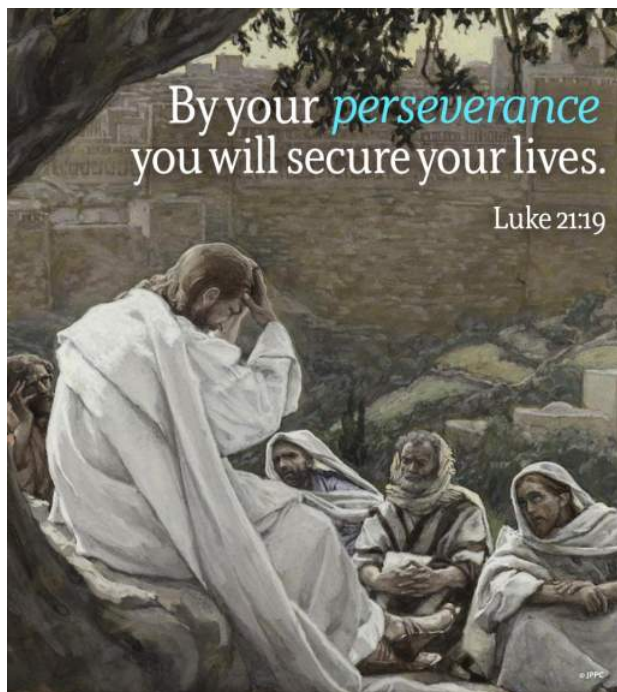

Paul was at his son's First Penance Service. His son, Andrew had just come back from talking to the priest with a big smile on his

face. "That wasn't scary at all, you were right!", he said to his Mom and Dad. And then Andy looked at his father and said, "Mommy just went to confession, aren't you going to go too?"

Now Paul couldn't remember the last time he had gone to confession. That was the last thing he wanted to do now. But for whatever reason he said to his son, "You know what, that's a great idea. I'll be right back."

And so Paul went to confession. As he waited in the line he began thinking over his life. He was even thinking that he had questioned why a person even had to bother to confess your sins to a priest anyway.

The line was getting shorter and in another minute it was his turn. So Paul goes into the Reconciliation Room and kneels behind the screen. He was nervous. Do I really tell my serious sins that I've been running from for all these years, or do I just say a few harmless sins and get the heck out of here?

Here's what came out of his mouth: "I guess I should be honest with you, Father, I'm really here because my son just asked me to do this. I want to set a good example, but I guess I really wasn't taking it seriously for myself. But for some reason I now feel that I should."

And so Paul confessed the serious sins — the things he was ashamed that he had done so many years ago: that he had been unfaithful to his wife back in the early ears of their marriage, that he had stolen from his company one time,

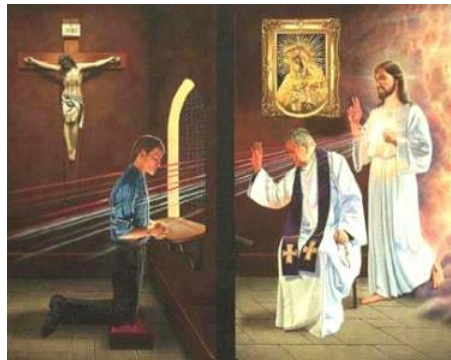
and that he was holding a lot of anger and resentment in his heart against his father.

The priest listened and didn't interrupt. When Paul was finished, he then said, "When I give you absolution for your sins you will be a completely new man. All these sins are taken away by Christ on the cross. He wants to be a part of your life and walk with you by your side as you leave this church. But do you realize that you are not here because you want to give good example to your son? That was the way that Christ called you back. You could have refused. Instead, you had character and courage to admit the truth---to admit you've done wrong, and now hopefully you will receive the grace of the sacrament. Commit yourself to Christ each day of your life. Stay with Him because he is faithful. Christ will strengthen you and guard you from all that is evil. And do your best now to forgive others as you have been forgiven by Christ."

We are asked to have the courage to make a commitment to Christ. This doesn't mean that we have to now magically make ourselves perfect in the sight of God. We have our weaknesses. We carry them with us whether we like it or not.

But remember this: Only those who have been forgiven by Christ and know they *need his forgiveness stay faithful to him*. Those who deny their weakness and think they don't need Jesus will end up drifting away or never really making that commitment.

Let Christ call you back to himself, no matter what your sins are or were. You asked to be faithful because there is something Jesus needs you to do for him. And that will be revealed in the Lord's good time.

Our outreach is caring, dignified, discreet and private.

Our team serves people in real situations — when money gets tight and it becomes impossible, for example, to pay a bill, buy food, or to surprise a child with a gift on Christmas morning. Difficult financial times can and do impact families, individuals, the elderly, the young, and especially single moms. When someone in need seeks assistance, it is often in utter desperation with nowhere else to turn. We need YOUR help:

- ◆ **Funding** — due to an increase in requests for support, our funding is nearly depleted. Assistance can be placed in the Poor Boxes at the church doors or by a donation ear-marked for Good Samaritan Ministry.
- ◆ **Ministry Team Members** — training and guidance are provided to new team members who will assist in responding to requests for support.

AMNION PREGNANCY CARE MEDICAL CENTER offers pre- and post pregnancy services.

Services provided are always free & confidential: pregnancy testing, ultrasounds, STD testing and treatment, abortion-pill reversal, prenatal support, parenting education & material assistance, options counseling, post-abortion care, educational and referral services.



BETHESDA PROJECT was founded in 1979 by a Catholic priest "to find and care for the abandoned poor and to be family

with those who have none." They provide shelter, housing, and supportive services across 11 locations to adults experiencing homelessness in Philadelphia. Their guests and residents experience a safe environment and a home where they can stabilize, regain their dignity and self-worth, and find community. bethesdaproject.org/



LEGACY OF LIFE FOUNDATION focuses on crisis pregnancy services, ongoing support, and advocacy. They invest in

educating, inspiring and supporting women in unplanned pregnancies to find the strength to choose life. They offer pregnancy testing and support throughout pregnancy and also post-pregnancy care for several years after the birth of their child.



MOTHER'S HOME is a residential shelter, providing a safe haven for vulnerable pregnant women in crisis who choose life as a sacred gift. They encourage their mothers to celebrate the joy of new life and help them to prepare for their future and the future of their child. They focus on physical, emotional and developmental needs including positive life skills, parenting and job preparation. They strive to assist our mothers to reach their goal of independence and self-sufficiency.



A BETTER WAY

A BETTER WAY teaches social responsibility skills and conflict management skills to youths between ages 12 and 18 who are involved in the juvenile justice system. This community program utilizes the Sanctuary Model of Trauma-

Informed Care to help individuals with issues of chronic adversity, loss, and trauma. abetterwaypa.org

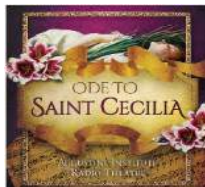
What Catholics Believe About Mary: Immaculate Conception, Virginity
