A couple of years ago, for our Lenten program, we focused on the Passion of Christ. We used the book and videos of Dr. Edward Sri, who is a theologian and international speaker on the Catholic faith. The series was called "No Greater Love: A Biblical Walk Through Christ's Passion. Most found this a very inspiring series.

When I read the readings for this Liturgy—Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, and re-read the Gospel selected in the Lectionary I had a flashback to the discussion about the scene at the Crucifixion and the exchange between the Good Thief and the Bad Thief. We have described for us a conversion moment for the Good Thief—who wasn't always good! He must have committed some serious crime to be where he was at that moment. This man repents of his sins and turns to Jesus before he dies. In the process he models three key steps of repentance we can apply to our own lives. The next time you have a sin you need to resend of—however big or small—follow these three steps of the good Thief on Good Friday:

Step One: Rebuke the Voice of the Enemy. The Evil Spirit often become for us the accuser, the one who puts self-condemning thoughts into our heads. We are overwhelmed with guilt, we feel horrible, we think we are beyond hope, etc. These are the words of the accuser who is trying to put us in a trap. So, shut out this voice. We



must turn towards God's Mercy. Sometimes the accuser can take a different tact. He can get us to rationalize our sins, to silence our conscience, in a way. Avoid this as well.

Step Two: Name our sin. That's why the Sacrament of Reconciliation can be such a good experience for us. This can be a freeing moment for the individual. Acknowledging what it is that we have done wrong and allowing the Lord to remove this burden.

Step Three: Entrust Yourself to Jesus' Mercy. The Good Thief, just by the way that he addresses Jesus, suggests that he has great confidence in what the Lord is capable of doing. He is placing himself in God's hands.

And we see how Jesus responds to this man's faith: Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."

Isn't it interesting that we are describing what took place on Calvary on this feast of Christ the King. And yet it is doing what Jesus was doing at this moment that we just observed that he is most the KING: forgiving sins and opening the gates of Paradise to one who is sorry for their sins. Within a scene of deep suffering, comes the opportunity to freedom and new life. How profound is that!! Yet this is what Christ, the King wants to offer to us as well—to break through our suffering and give us a new life. By our wounds we can be set free. Let our prayer be (repeated over and over again): "Jesus, remember me when you come in your kingly power."

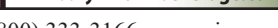
