Bill sat alone at an isolated corner of the bar. This is where he was spending a lot of his time lately. It was the only way, it seemed, to relieve the pressure---numb the

depression.

He just didn't seem to have any answers anymore. Julia, his wife, was definitely going through with the divorce. And Bill had to admit, he really couldn't blame her. He *had* been a jerk. It was just hard to accept that she had met someone that (well at least *she said*) made her happy---someone she could depend on.

But Bill hadn't been very dependable. Drinking had gotten in the way of that, along with other things as well. It seemed that throughout his life Bill had been offered many opportunities. Yet he always seems to make the wrong decisions. Maybe because those decisions had been made with him thinking only about himself and not his wife or family, or anyone else. And so, as he took another sip of his drink, he thought, "How did I end up like this?"

When Bill usually began to actually answer this question it would be about blaming everyone else, his friends in college, where the trouble really began, his parents for not understanding him, his wife for being too hard on him and nagging him, his supervisors for being incompetent, and on and on.

But, for some reason this night, he wasn't going down that path. Maybe that's the grace of the moment: Bill's realization that he had to stop

blaming everyone else. Maybe Bill needed some professional help---and even more so---some spiritual help.

"How did I end up like this?" We may have asked ourselves this question at certain times in our life. Maybe our experience is similar to Bill. Are we blaming everyone else for what ultimately were our own bad, or self-centered, decisions?

Today we begin Advent. Not a count-down to Christmas, but a time of preparation for the coming of Christ more fully into our lives. If we are wondering how to get things working again---moving in the right direction--- but don't know how, this season reminds us that Jesus is the one who can help us fulfill our most basic need, union with God and peace in his presence---peace within our selves.

If we've lost contact with God because we have stopped praying or going to church, we can start over again. No matter how long it has been, there's a chance to return. And the best way to begin the process of returning is to say, "Jesus, help me."

"It is now the hour for you to wake from sleep", "Throw off works of darkness", and "you must be prepared". These are the words of Scripture. Jesus is saying, "Stop the pattern of bad decisions, stop being afraid and overwhelmed." Turn to the God who sent us His Son as mediator and friend.

Remember what God says in the Old Testament: "I am the salvation of the people. If they cry to me in their distress, I will hear them and be their God forever.
