Mark felt very frustrated that he wasn't able to get his act together these days. He knew what he was supposed to do, but he just didn't feel like doing it. Instead

he would waste time on things that were not all that important, or things that were more connected to hobbies that interested him. But eventually this would lead to use of the Internet, and when that happened eventually he would start to venture where he knew he shouldn't go. One thing would lead to another, and then he would fall...

Mark was confessing his sins to the priest one Saturday in confession, and he said, without intending to, "Father, I'm just so frustrated with myself and my life. I do have a good life, but I can't seem to get my act together. And when I fall into sin I really start to feel guilty and struggle to come up with a plan that will work for me so that I can conquer this stuff!"

And the priest said to him, "It's not about your trying to solve your problem on your own. Christ is the one who will give you the grace to eventually transform you. But if you rely solely on your own resources you will get nowhere. The most important thing is to not give up hope. God's doing more for you than you actually realize. And I know this may sound strange, but Christ is actually to be found in the very center of that struggle you are going through. Christ is doing something for you that will make sense to you sometime later. In the meantime, persevere and put your trust in the truth that God knows what he's doing.

St John the Baptist recognized who Jesus was the moment he saw him: "Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world." And his way of describing Jesus was to say, "he's the one

that will free you from your sins". This is the primary purpose of Christ's mission.

But it's also important that we have a "healthy" sense of what sin is all about. A great Scripture scholar offered a great insight regarding sin vs repentance that I think can help change our perspective:

"God desires the sinner to turn away from the darkness of his own nothingness...and come to himself; to draw life from his own life. *Sin* is grounded in an illusion concerning my own alleged greatness and worth *in my own eyes*. *Repentance* is grounded, not in a desire to abase myself, but in a clear understanding and a profound conviction of my great worth *in the eyes of God*.

Sometimes pride can set us up to fall into the traps that sin sets for us. And this often happens because we are looking at things only from our perspective. But rather than buy into pride and then guilt, are asked to try and sense how we may be viewed through God's eyes. We seek forgiveness or repentance confident in God's love for us. Confident that we have worth in God's eyes despite our sins.

John the Baptist clearly sees who Christ is and knows what he is about. We need to see who Christ is in our own lives and allow Him to heal us and bring us strength. The very place where we think we are the farthest from Christ—in our weakness, becomes the place where he is closest to us. So, don't despair. Keep asking for Jesus to help you. Bring your brokenness to the Lord and remember how he see you.

Also, be mindful of this: Sometimes God does us a favor without us realizing it. Don't forget, we are all being purified of our old ways of acting and thinking so that we can live the life we were meant to live: a live united with Christ.

Jan 26: Saints Timothy and Titus, Bishops

—**St. Timothy (d. 97)**, born in Galatia in Asia Minor, was baptized and later ordained to the priesthood by St. Paul. The young Galatian became Paul's missionary companion and his most beloved spiritual son. St. Paul showed his trust in this disciple by consecrating him bishop of the great city of Ephesus. St. Timothy was stoned to death thirty years after St. Paul's martyrdom for having denounced the worship of the goddess Diana.



—**St. Titus (d. 96)**, a convert from paganism, was a fellow laborer of St. Paul on many apostolic missions. St. Paul later made him bishop of Crete, a difficult charge because of the character of the inhabitants and the spread of erroneous doctrines on that island. St. Paul's writings tell us that St. Titus rejoiced to discover what was good in others and drew the hearts of men by his wide and affectionate sympathy. Catholicculture.org

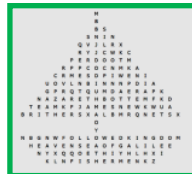
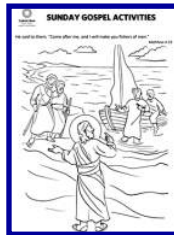

January 28: St. Thomas Aquinas, Priest and Doctor of the Church (1225-1274)

St. Thomas Aquinas was born in 1225 in the Kingdom of Sicily. He was born into an extremely powerful and wealthy family who wanted him to join the Benedictines. Instead, Aquinas joined the Dominicans so he could live a life of study and scholarship. Aquinas became a Doctor of the Church and the father of Thomism, a school of thought that built upon the Aristotelian basis of the existence and reason of God. Aquinas' most famous work, the unfinished Summa Theologica, is still one of the most influential texts in the Church today. 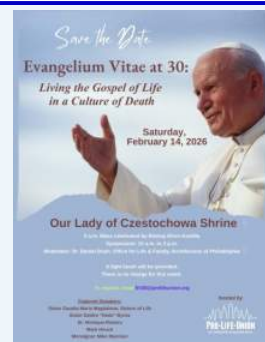
