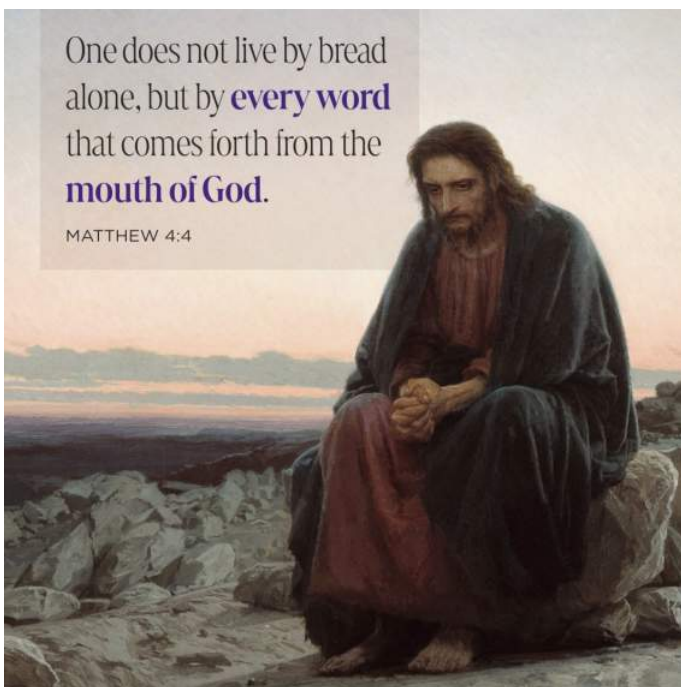

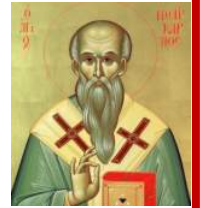
Fasting & Abstinence

- ◆ **Abstinence:** All persons 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday.
- ◆ **Fasting:** All persons 18 years of age and older, up to and including their 59th birthday, are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.
- ◇ If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

Feb. 23: St. Polycarp, Bishop and Martyr

St. Polycarp was a follower of St. John the Evangelist. He had the opportunity to learn about the life of Jesus from those who had walked with the Lord during his time on earth. St. Polycarp was in the second generation of Church leaders, and he had to navigate a lot of questions and heresies in the absence of the apostles. When making challenging decisions for the early Church, he tried to imitate the grace and charity of Jesus. Polycarp became Bishop of Smyrna. His preaching influenced St. Irenaeus, many of whose works survive today. For Polycarp's work developing theology in the early Church, he is considered one of the Apostolic Fathers, a group of theologians in the early Church who directly knew the Apostles.

As much as Jean tried to forgive her ex-husband for what he did to her, she just couldn't get there. The marriage was nothing like what Jean expected it would be. During the engagement some things began to manifest themselves: the drinking too much at parties, the temper, the self-centeredness. But by this point Jean thought that she could help him to get beyond those things.

Sadly, after they were married, it actually got worse. When Jean found evidence that Joe had been cheating on her and lying about his whereabouts, she said to herself, "enough is enough".

The divorce, thankfully, was swift. But what really hurt Jean was that her husband gave her the impression that there had never been anything there---no love, ever. When Jean suggested that they separate for a while, Joe had just wanted to move towards divorce. It was as if Joe just couldn't wait to be free of her.

Now Joe is remarried. He did this as soon as he could, which also hurt Jean very much, and she started getting angry with herself, feeling like a fool, having wasted so much time, and being so hopeful and trusting towards a person who never really cared about her to begin with!

And now there was the resentment, along with the anger and the embarrassment of a divorce. These were the feelings that were filling her every waking moment. The only relief she got was when she was super busy at work. So that's what she did; worked long hours to forget the

pain. But she noticed something was happening to her. She was becoming a cynical and mean person herself. Her capacity to trust was gone and she couldn't help but think the worst of people's intentions. And because of this she pretty much kept to herself. Even her closest friends were having a hard time trying to reach her.

It's not always easy to forgive. So when someone like Jean hears Jesus' words, "go and be reconciled with your brother" or "settle with your opponent quickly" she's probably thinking: no way, or I'm not there yet---I may never get there.

Yet, despite very difficult situations, I think that Christ still gives good advice. Because if we don't find a way to let go of the feelings that eat away at us and start to change our personality, we find ourselves moving toward a kind of "death". So, when you are in a situation where it seems almost impossible to even think about forgiveness, put the "ball" in Jesus' court. Picture yourself actually placing all that hurt at the foot of the cross. Pray: Lord, now I see why you went to the cross---so that I might have a chance at letting go of all that brings me pain---of all that hurts me and makes me less than the person I am called to be.



This might not seem like a plan that will work. And it might take doing many times, but Christ hears and responds. Pain of this type takes time to ease up, so you do have to be patient. But giving in to all those feelings that we think will give us a sense of satisfaction, will slowly "kill" us emotionally and spiritually. So take Jesus' advice. It's not just one of those pious platitudes.

We invite you to step away from your daily routine and connect with Jesus through a prayerful journey on his way of the cross.

Tradition holds that Jesus walked from Pilate's praetorium to Golgotha (the Place of the Skull) on his last day on earth. The devotion known as "the way", or Stations of the Cross (Via Crucis), originated with pilgrims who walked the Via Dolorosa (the "way of tears") in Jerusalem. This began during the Turkish occupation of the Holy Land in the late Middle Ages, when pilgrims were prevented from visiting sacred sites. The custom arose of making replicas of those holy places, where the faithful might come to pray. By the late sixteenth century the fourteen stations, as we know them today, were erected in most Catholic churches.

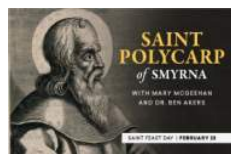
