Lately, Kathy has felt unsettled. She's been struggling with the direction her life has taken. And here are

some of the burning questions that have been going through her head:

Am I really happy with the *way I am living*?

Can I continue to ignore the emptiness that I feel within myself?

Isn't life supposed to be more than this?

Why do I always seem to hurt those who love me and need me?

In my heart I I'm searching for "something" that I know I cannot find living this way. Where can I find *real fulfillment*?

When I'm older, and near the end of my life, will I look back on all this and be happy with the decisions I have made?



When a person begins to ask questions like these, believe it or not, it is really a sign that God tapping you on the shoulder—God is active in your life. Our lives may not have turned out the way we had expected, or perhaps we really want to change our behavior, but don't seem to have the ability to do this on our own. We can feel unsettled, disappointed, and maybe even depressed. But another way to look at it is to see *God's call* to rely on his grace to get us moving in the right direction.

So, for those of us who have tried to live life on our own, *ignoring the voice of the Shepherd*, there comes a time when we finally realize there's a better way. Jesus opens the gate and wants to free us from the traps we find ourselves in. But once we pass through the gate, we are to follow the voice of the Shepherd who wants to lead us to a new pasture.

Remember: The burning questions of life, and the nagging sense of being unsettled are both graces from God. God is present in the midst of all the chaos (in the very heart of it). He's saying, "I will help you."

Christ *wants us to pay attention to Him*. So don't keep your hearts closed to what's happening. Ignoring Christ's call usually leads to more feeling of being unsettled.

Place the burning questions before the Risen Lord. Patiently listen to the *voice of the Shepherd*. *Tell the Shepherd that you trust him*.

Remember what Jesus went to the cross. His Father was very serious about saving us. The Lord wants us to reach out for the gift that was purchased at so great a price. Don't let the gift remain unopened.

The gate has been unlocked, and we are set free! Heed the voice of the Shepherd who loves you!

We expect our church renovation to begin in May, possibly as soon as during the week of May 11.

**Daily Mass will be in the Gathering Room.** The Gathering Room will become a chapel and thus the location of daily Mass for the duration of the church construction.

**Saturday Vigil & Sunday Masses will be celebrated in the gym.** While school is still in session, the gym will be set up on Saturday afternoon and taken down after our Sunday Masses conclude.

**Caring for Friends:** Please use the freezers at the Life Center.

**The Church Renovation is expected to take about 10 months, finishing in March 2027.**

**The school interior renovation, sprinkler installation, and new addition will begin after school wraps up in early June.**

- ◆ The interior renovation and installation of the sprinkler system (in the original school buildings) will take place during the summer, to be ready for the opening of school in September.
- ◆ The new addition will take about 10 months; our goal is to finish in March of 2027.

**To aid communication of plans for site logistics & management during the renovation, we will distribute a fact sheet.**

- ◆ Updates will be issued if/as new circumstances arise.

my dearest friend, my Savior, my everything.

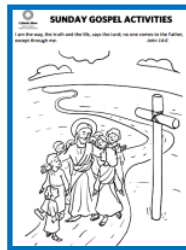
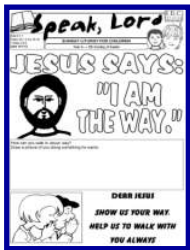
Let Your Spirit guide me each day

**MAY IS THE MONTH OF MARY**

The month of May is a special time when Catholics honor the Blessed Virgin Mary with prayers, crownings and processions. While several months throughout the year observe Marian celebrations, May is known as the Month of Mary.

Honoring Mary during May began as early as the 13th century, when specific days in May were devoted to Mary. May is also associated with spring and new life, which Mary represents as the mother of Jesus, who gave the world new life through his death and resurrection.

Those who venerate Mary have a deep respect for her place in God's plan. They recognize her holiness and see her as a mother figure of the Church. Mary is a model of faith because of her obedience, humility, and complete trust in God.

**HOW YOU CAN HONOR MARY IN MAY**

There are several ways you can make Marian devotions to the Blessed Mother more personal in May. Here are a few ideas to help you get started.

**PRAY THE ROSARY-** During May, set aside time to pray the Rosary daily. You can pray the Rosary while you get ready for work, while you walk or exercise, or as you're preparing dinner.



**MAKE A MARIAN SHRINE-** Find a quiet place in your home where you can pray daily. Put an image or statue of the Virgin Mary in that place and keep your rosary there. Make the space a part of your prayer routine while you ask the Blessed Mother for her intercession.

**PLANT A MARIAN GARDEN-** Spring is the perfect time to plant a garden dedicated to Mary. Give each flower you plant an intention so when it blooms in the garden, it blooms in your heart as well. If you don't have space for planting, try to keep fresh flowers in your home or on your Marian Shrine throughout the month.

**CREATE A SPECIAL MARIAN PRAYER-** The Hail Mary, Memorare, Magnificat and Rosary are all prayers you can say to honor Mary in May. But you can also devise your own personal prayer to Mary, thanking her for guidance, asking for her intercession, or just praying for peace.

**A PATH TO CHRIST-** Marian devotion is a significant part of Catholicism. During May, you can show your love for and veneration of Mary in several ways. Take time to reflect on Mary's faith and her role as the mother of Jesus and the Church's spiritual mother. As a role model of faith, Mary lovingly brings your prayers to her son, Jesus.
