It is April, 1945. Father Alfred Delp, a Jesuit priest is sitting in a Nazi prison in the ruined city of Berlin. He has been found guilty of treason in a mockery of a trial where

trumped up charges were thrown at him. Even though the war is all but lost the Nazi propaganda machine still grinds on. Fr. Delp is awaiting execution. As he sits in this prison, he's praying. Here's his prayer:

Lord, you have created me to do some definite service. You have committed some work to me that you have not given to anyone else. Whatever may happen, wherever I am, I can never be thrown away. If I am in sickness, my sickness may serve you. If in perplexity, my perplexity may serve you. If I am in sorrow, my sorrow may serve you. You do nothing in vain. You know what you are doing, therefore I will trust you.

What faith to be able to say a prayer like that given the circumstances that Alfred Delp found himself in! Instead of fear, or a desire to save himself, he is focusing on God's purpose for his life. What kind of a relationship did this man have with Christ that he could face death so peacefully?

Where do you stand with God? What kind of relationship do you have with him? Do we look at life in the way that says: I will make my own decisions for myself, and I don't have to be accountable to anyone. Yet, a prayer like Fr. Delp prayed surely looks at life much differently. The emphasis is on God's purposes, not mine.

As we acknowledge God today as Father, Son and Spirit — one God three persons — we also acknowledge that it was God who gave us life. We didn't just happen. And just as the Trinity is about relationships, this God wants to have a relationship with us. So, the closer we get to the Father, Son and Spirit, the better we understand what God has in mind for us, the clearer sense of God's will for us.

In our younger years we think that we can set our goals, control our destiny, measure our success, understand how to get somewhere in life. When we are older, despite our successes we still feel there's something missing. Eventually we realize that we are settling for far less than what it is that God is offering.

And as our perspective changes we see more and more that God is within us and around us. There's more to life than just "me" and my problems — my ups and downs. We start to love the way Jesus taught us: doing what is best for the other person.

What's missing? A closer relationship with Christ. Remember, Christ doesn't reveal himself to us and then walk away from us.

Believe in God. Place your life in his hands. Remember the words of Fr. Delp' prayer: You did not create me without purpose... you do nothing in vain, therefore I will trust you.

Cast yourself upon God and have no fear. He will not shrink away and let you fall. Cast yourself upon him without fear, for he will welcome you and cure you of your ills.

#### A Prayer of Trust

*Lord, you have created me to do some definite service.

If I am in sickness, my sickness may serve you.  
If in perplexity, my perplexity may serve you.

You know what you are doing, therefore I will trust you.*

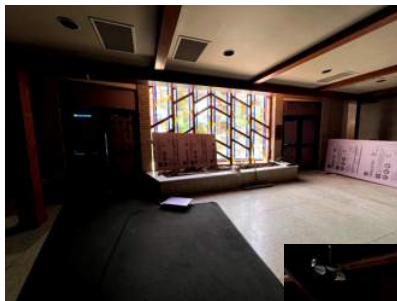
**OUR SUNDAY 5:15 PM MASS WILL BE SUSPENDED

Staff and faculty have been hard at work packing up! The modular classrooms/trailers have been cleared out and have been completely disconnected from our school building.

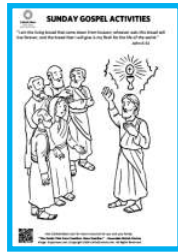

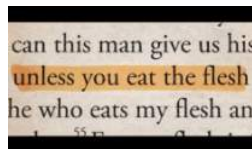
### Bread of Life: The Eucharist in Galilee
