The academic dean of Benedictine College wrote this very touching reflection about the Body and Blood of

Christ:

“Ever since my son was badly injured in a car accident in 2013, I have found new signs of God’s presence everywhere. My son is totally disabled; he can’t speak or walk; he can barely move. Yet every day he is the focal point of incredible love and tenderness from friends, caregivers, and even people he just meets.

This means, for me and my husband, that caring for him in his “brokenness” gives us a chance to touch and feel the outpouring of divine love and mercy in a special way, through the love and support of all who share this journey with us.

And so, the feast of Corpus Christi has a new meaning in my life; it speaks directly to my heart. Christ’s body, broken on the cross for us, opened a channel through which the love of God could cascade into the world to be touched and felt. Jesus’ wounded and bleeding body is transformed in the Eucharist into the most wonderful gift of his love for us. Just so, my son’s suffering has been transformed, through the love he has been surrounded with, into a sign of God’s tremendous mercy and compassion.

We are so blessed to have this ongoing reminder of that mercy and compassion. Just being with our son is like a daily Corpus Christi celebration. Our life together is a dramatic revelation of the way in which God can make all things, even the most harrowing, signs of his tender love.”

This reflection really caught my attention because of the focus on the brokenness of Jesus’ body and how that became the means or the channel for God’s love to pour into the world, which is itself broken and in need of healing.

The person who wrote this reflection allowed the grace of the Sacrament of the Eucharist to transform the tragedy of her son’s car accident into an experience of love—God’s love manifested through Jesus’ death on the cross so vividly lived out in the care and community surrounding her son and all those who come in contact with him.



The Eucharist is the very core of our faith. Our main purpose here at this parish is to follow Christ and live out his message and *to gather around the Eucharist. The celebration of the Eucharist is what unites us and protects us.*

Also, we must allow the presence of Jesus to heal our brokenness and give us a new perspective on life. Through faith we have the ability to persevere and to learn each day to trust God more deeply.

## It was a big week at SCJN School! Staff, teachers and students came together to wrap up the school year one week early and enthusiastically helped prepare the rooms for construction!



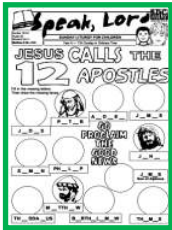
As the last vehicles left campus for summer break, the workmen rolled in to begin preparation of the school. Not a minute was lost!

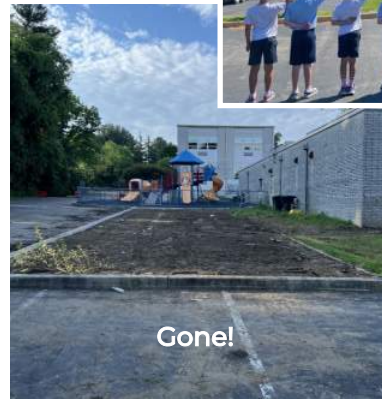

## Prayer to Be Missionary Disciples

### June 19: St. Romuald, Abbot

In the midst of a wasted youth, Saint Romuald watched his father kill a relative in a duel over property. In horror he fled to a monastery near Ravenna. After three years, some of the monks found him to be uncomfortably holy and eased him out.

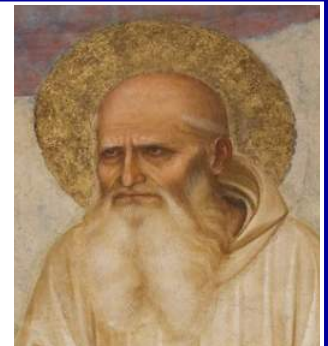
Romuald spent the next 30 years going about Italy, founding monasteries and hermitages. He longed to give his life to Christ in martyrdom, and got the pope's permission to preach the gospel in Hungary. But he was struck with illness as soon as he arrived, and the illness recurred as often as he tried to proceed.

During another period of his life, Saint Romuald suffered great spiritual dryness. One day as he was praying [Psalm 31](#) (“I will give you understanding and I will instruct you”), he was given an extraordinary light and spirit which never left him.

At the next monastery where he stayed, Saint Romuald was accused of a scandalous crime by a young nobleman he had rebuked for a dissolute life. Amazingly, his fellow monks believed the accusation. He was given a severe penance, forbidden from offering Mass, and excommunicated—an unjust sentence that he endured in silence for six months.

The most famous of the monasteries Saint Romuald founded was that of the Camaldoli in Tuscany. Here began the Order of the Camaldolese Benedictines, uniting the monastic and eremitical lives. In later life Romuald's own father became a monk, wavered, and was kept faithful by the encouragement of his son.

Christ is a gentle leader, but he calls us to total holiness. Now and then, men and women are raised up to challenge us by the absoluteness of their dedication, the vigor of their spirit, the depth of their conversion. The fact that we cannot duplicate their lives does not change the call to us to be totally open to God in our own particular circumstances. [franciscanmedia.org](http://franciscanmedia.org)
