There's a girl who has a pretty difficult father. The father is an alcoholic who never thought he had a problem, and so never did

anything about it. The girl's time growing up was very difficult. All she ever wanted from her father was that he shows some interest in her. The girl eventually leaves home and gets her own apartment. She never hears from her father. A few years go by and one day there's a call from the father. He says: "So good to hear your voice."

Could this be a conversion moment? Was he calling to apologize, perhaps? Here's what he says: "I'm in jail, can you bail me out. Another driving accident, and the police took me in this time..." The girl tells the father how self-centered he is, that she will not bail him out, and then hangs up the phone. She collapses in tears.

The girl tries to pray to calm herself down, she's so upset. And here's what she prays for: *The grace to forgive so that her spirit doesn't get crushed.* She doesn't pray that everything will be worked out, rather she says, "Lord, rescue me from feeling resentful."

That was a very good prayer. You see, there really isn't a happy ending to this story—at least one that has the girl calling her father and saying that she forgives him, etc. But you could say there's a happy ending in that *she is putting herself on the right path.* Eventually, through the help of others, and talking things out with the right people, she learns some things that *help her to change the way she thinks.*

A friend tells her: "You can't control this, you didn't cause it, you didn't ask for this. Better

to keep your eyes fixed on Christ and try not to get all 'nuts' about what you can't control."

Resentment is one disease that destroys a person's spirit—a person's soul, in fact. It can lead to self-pity and a desire for retaliation that goes nowhere. It's like bees who kill themselves stinging others. Instead, we must concentrate on Christ and his cross and what it means for each of us.

That's how you make it through the storm; by trying to look at Christ and not yourself. Also, know that Jesus is present *in the storm.* Notice how he appears to Peter emerging from the wind and the waves. He's with you through the storm.

The apostles weren't expecting this. They thought they were seeing a ghost. When Peter keeps his gaze on Christ, he is able to walk on the water, but when he turns away from Jesus' gaze and sees how rough the water is, he starts sinking.

There's a pattern that we can see: the storm (life's challenges), the wind and the waves (our fears which cause doubts), the sinking (giving in to despair or resentment and anger). The worst is when a person does not ask for help when they start sinking.

For Peter, for the girl in our story, for you and me, here's what it means to be a disciple—staying on the right path: always trying, sometimes failing, always trying again.

It's a far better thing to try again than to give up and give in to things like resentment, anger and frustration. The presence of Christ and the love which flows from the cross bring peace, serenity, calm.

The chairs are available for those who appreciate armrests to facilitate standing and sitting.

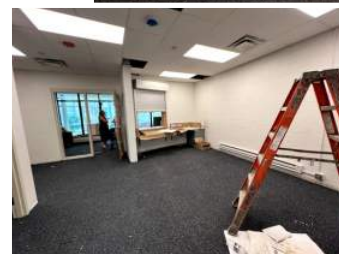

The new Sensory Room and Learning Support Room are taking shape:



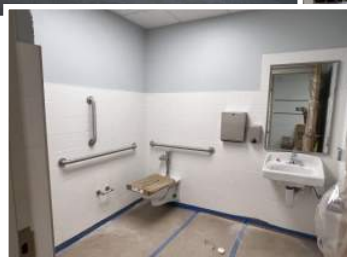
New carpeting is installed in a number of classrooms, along with new lighting!

The classroom furniture & items stored in the cafeteria are beginning to move back to the classrooms!



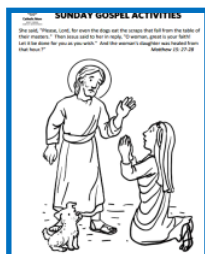

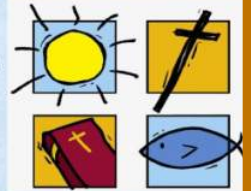
